WISCONSIN GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY BOARD TO MEET

The State of Wisconsin Government Accountability Board will meet Tuesday, November 11, 2008, at 9:30 A.M. in **Room 300 Southeast at the State Capitol**, Madison, Wisconsin.

The Board intends to hold a public hearing and act on the following:

- Proposed administrative rule GAB Chapter 4, Election Observers.
- Proposed administrative rule GAB Chapter 5, Ballot and Electronic Voting Security.
- Proposed Action Regarding Retroactive HAVA Checks
- Use of blind trusts.
- Proposed Administrative Rule Relating to Definition of "Political Purposes".
- Review and reaffirm, modify, or withdraw the Elections Board's operating procedures, opinions, and rules relating to training and selecting election officials; and duties and responsibilities of campaign treasurers.
- Review and reaffirm, modify, or withdraw the Ethics Board's operating procedures, opinions, and rules relating to local officials' conflicts of interest, acceptance of items, and other matters.

The Board intends to hear staff reports on:

- Elections Division Activities;
- Ethics & Accountability Division Activities; and
- Administrative Activities.

Following the open session of its meeting, the Government Accountability Board intends to adjourn to closed session, as required by statute, to confer with counsel concerning litigation, to consider written requests for advisory opinions; and to address the investigation of possible violations of Wisconsin's lobbying law, campaign finance law, and Code of Ethics for Public Officials and Employees.
