SUBJECT: Ballot Access for the 2014 General Election

This memorandum presents a summary of important and noteworthy information about candidates requesting ballot access for the 2014 General Election.

Summary

The nomination paper filing deadline for the 2014 General Election for constitutional, congressional and legislative offices was 5:00 pm on Tuesday, June 2, 2014. Three hundred sixty six (366) candidates registered for the election. Fifty (50) registrants did not submit any nomination papers, two of which are registered write-in candidates, and five are incumbents who had registered for the election and later filed a Notification of Noncandidacy.

A total of three hundred sixteen (316) candidates filed nomination papers with the Government Accountability Board Elections Division. The first day to circulate nomination papers was April 15, 2014. By the first of May, Elections Division staff received five (5) sets of nomination papers, with the first set filed on Monday, April 21st. Between May 2nd and May 16th, staff received twenty nine (29) sets of papers. During the week of May 19th, forty two (42) sets were received. During the four-day week beginning on Tuesday, May 27th, one hundred forty one (141) sets were received, thirty five of which were submitted on Friday, May 30th. The remaining ninety nine (99) sets were received on the June 2nd deadline.

Notifications of Noncandidacy

Thirty two (32) incumbents filed notifications of noncandidacy with the Elections Division by the May 23, 2014 deadline. These were incumbents who were not seeking re-election to their currently held office. No incumbent failed to timely file a notification of noncandidacy so

there was no 72-hour extension for any office. A listing of candidates who filed notifications of noncandidacy is included with this memo.

Nomination Paper Review

In reviewing the nomination papers, staff examined each candidate's submission to determine that it contained a valid number of signatures for the office.

- Candidates for Statewide Constitutional Offices must file a minimum of **2,000** valid signatures of qualified electors of the state to qualify for ballot access. Wis. Stat. § 8.15 (6)(a).
- Candidates for Representative in Congress must file a minimum of **1,000** valid signatures of qualified electors from the district to qualify for ballot access. Wis. Stat. § 8.15(6)(b).
- Candidates for State Senator must file a minimum of **400** valid signatures of qualified electors from the district to qualify for ballot access. Wis. Stat. § 8.15 (6)(c).
- Candidates for Representative to the Assembly must file a minimum of **200** valid signatures of qualified electors from the district to qualify for ballot access. Wis. Stat. § 8.15(6)(d).

Each state candidate is also required to file a Campaign Registration Statement (GAB-1), Declaration of Candidacy (GAB-162), and Statement of Economic Interests (SEI) in order to qualify for ballot access. Wis. Stat. §§ 11.05(2g), 8.21, 19.43(4). For the 2014 Fall Elections, Statements of Economic Interests were due in the G.A.B.'s office by Thursday, June 5, 2014 before 4:30 p.m. If a 2014 Statement of Economic Interest (SEI) was already filed with the G.A.B. for another purpose, that Statement was used to fulfill the filing requirement. Extensions for the form are only given when an incumbent fails to timely file a Notice of Noncandidacy. G.A.B. staff accepts Statements via mail, fax or email and electronic signatures are accepted. When a Statement is turned in, G.A.B. staff review the document for any errors and signatures. Accepted Statements are recorded as being received and filed away. All Statements for 2014 Fall Candidates are available for public inspection.

Federal candidates are only required to file a Declaration of Candidacy in addition to their nomination papers. Wis. Stat. § 8.21. Failure to file any required ballot access document prevents the candidate's name from appearing on the ballot. Wis. Stat. § 8.30. Staff used the guidance provided in GAB 2.05 to review the nomination papers submitted to determine if a given signature was facially valid. No affirmative steps were taken to find and eliminate duplicate signatures or signatures from individuals who are ineligible to vote due to age, residency, citizenship, or other disqualifying factors. However, approximately 13,000 signatures were struck for a variety of issues including incomplete addresses, dates, illegible printed name or an incomplete certification of the circulator.

2013 Wisconsin Act 160 provides that in order for a signature on a nomination paper to be valid, the signer must also legibly print his or her name. On its face, the purpose of this

legislation seems simple enough. But questions arose when staff began to review the first set of nomination papers. "What does 'print' mean?" "Must the letters in the printed name be separate from one another?" "What about 'hybrid' printing; a combination of cursive writing and printing?"

A management decision was made to take a literal approach to determining whether a name was legibly printed, rather than assume the Legislature used the word "printed" to merely augment the term "legible." This resulted in a higher than usual number of signatures being struck. Scrutinizing printed names also slowed the process of review considerably.

It has been the policy of the staff of the Government Accountability Board and its predecessor agency, the State Elections Board, to review all nomination papers and make a determination regarding sufficiency within 24 hours of submission. Further, for papers received on deadline day, a determination regarding sufficiency is to be made before staff retires for the evening. For the first time since this policy was instituted in the early 1990s by then Executive Director Kennedy, staff did not meet this requirement. Despite a valiant attempt and an extremely late night, staff was unable to complete the review of all nomination papers received on the deadline, and review was completed on Tuesday morning, June 3, 2014. Staff was able to make determinations with respect to sufficiency within 24-48 hours for all papers received through Friday, May 30th. Staff worked on Saturday, May 31st to review papers received on Friday, May 30th.

In total, staff reviewed roughly 219,163 signatures (approximately 12,000 more than in 2012). Over forty percent of the total signatures reviewed, 89,554, were submitted on June 2, 2014. Staff determined 206,098 of those signatures were valid. Staff made extensive use of temporary services personnel to provide the necessary capacity to review nomination papers within the same day they were submitted.

By the deadline for filing nomination papers, one hundred nineteen (119) candidates had also filed additional nomination papers or correcting affidavits to supplement their original filing.

Irregularities in Ballot Access Documents Not Affecting Ballot Status

During review of nomination papers and other ballot access documents, Elections Division staff identified the following irregularities, none of which affected ballot status:

- Staff allowed for irregularities in listing office titles, such as "Assembly," "State Assembly," "State Legislature," "Assembly Seat," "Senate," "Senator" and "Member of Congress." Staff determined that the papers were sufficient as long as the electors could determine the office and district the candidate was pursuing by information provided in the nomination paper heading. In all cases the district sought was identified.
- Staff identified candidates who used the primary date of August 12, 2014 and candidates who used August 12 or 8/12 but did not indicate the year "2014." One candidate used "fall election" rather than "general election." In all cases, staff determined that the electors understood the nomination papers were for the fall 2014 general election.

- Three candidates used a nomination paper format that did not include the extra language regarding the qualifications of the nomination paper circulator. On April 17, 2014, the Board had determined that signatures would not be struck because of this omission.
- A number of candidates submitted sets of nomination papers that contained pages where either or both the affirmation of signer or certification of circulator wording was cut off during duplication of the nomination paper template prior to circulation. In all cases if the meaning could still be understood, signatures were not struck.
- Although staff does not actively search for duplicate signatures, several were discovered. One candidate had signed his own nomination papers three times on pages the candidate had circulated himself.
- Staff discovered photocopied pages mixed in with original pages in several sets of papers. Most of the instances did not reduce the number of valid signatures to below the minimum. (See No. 6 in the "Candidates Recommended by Staff to be Denied Ballot Access" section.
- There were at least five candidates whose papers contained signatures that appeared to be written or printed by the same person. Staff allowed for the benefit of the doubt, leaving allegations of forgery to the challenge process.

Staff Recommendations for Ballot Status

A listing of candidates recommended for ballot status is included with this memorandum. Staff requests the Board affirmatively approve the ballot status of those candidates listed who have met or exceeded the minimum valid signatures and have filed all necessary ballot access documents.

Candidates Recommended by Staff to be Denied Ballot Access

Staff recommends that the following candidates be denied ballot status.

- Marcia Mercedes Perkins, candidate for Governor
 On June 2, 2014, Ms. Perkins filed approximately 2,040 signatures on 204
 nomination paper pages, none of which contained a printed name column or other
 area for an elector to print his or her name as required by law. Staff determined the
 papers were insufficient at zero signatures. Candidate Perkins has also filed a
 compliance review complaint.
- 2. <u>Nancy L. Olson</u>, candidate for Representative in Congress, District 6 On June 2, 2014, Ms. Olson submitted approximately 400 signatures. The minimum number of signatures required for Congressional office is 1,000. Staff reviewed the submission and determined the papers were insufficient at 383 signatures.

- 3. <u>Barry Nelson</u>, candidate for State Senator, District 9
 On June 2, 2014, Mr. Nelson submitted approximately 420 signatures. Due to signatures obtained out of the district, the candidate could not rehabilitate enough signatures to achieve the minimum number required. Staff determined the papers were insufficient at 369 signatures.
- 4. <u>Jon Kruse</u>, candidate for Representative to the Assembly, District 1 On May 29, 2014, Mr. Kruse filed 240 valid signatures, but failed to file a Statement of Economic Interests by Thursday, June 5, 2014. Staff determined that Mr. Kruse failed to file all required ballot access documents.
- 5. <u>Craig Krueger</u>, Representative to the Assembly, District 25 On June 2, 2014, Mr. Krueger filed approximately 237 nomination paper signatures. None of the pages contained a printed name column or other area for an elector to print his or her name as required by law. Staff determined the papers were insufficient at zero signatures. Candidate Krueger has also filed a compliance review complaint.
- 6. <u>Jim Swanson</u>, candidate for Representative to the Assembly, District 29 On June 2, 2014, Mr. Swanson filed 36 pages of nomination papers containing approximately 300 signatures. Sixteen pages were photocopies. Staff determined the papers were insufficient at 157 signatures.
- 7. Rich Martin, candidate for Representative to the Assembly, District 55 On June 2, 2014, Mr. Martin filed approximately 260 signatures. All of the signatures were obtained using the nonpartisan nomination paper template. Therefore, there was no indication of party or statement of principle. Staff determined the papers were insufficient at zero signatures.
- 8. <u>48 candidates</u> for various offices 48 candidates registered for an office but did not submit nomination papers.

Challenges to Ballot Status

The deadline for challenges to ballot status was Thursday, June 5, 2014, and candidates. Challenges will be discussed in a separate memorandum and presented by staff counsels.

Compliance Review Appeals

Gary Kauther, Candidate for the 25th Senate District – EL 14-03

Candidate Kauther filed 45 pages of nomination papers containing 449 signatures on May 21, 2014. Staff initially noted irregularities in the header, including listing the title of the office sought as "Senate" rather than "State Senate" and a missing year of election, and deemed these pages invalid. Staff reviewed the pages and noted 359 signatures that would be valid if not for the header irregularities, short of the 400 needed for the office of State Senate. Candidate Kauther circulated additional papers with the correct information in the header and filed supplemental signatures on May 28, 2014, of which 48 were approved by staff. On

May 28, Candidate Kauther also filed a complaint under Wis. Stat. § 5.06 challenging the initial decision of Board staff that determined all of his signatures were invalid.

Candidate Kauther argues that his papers should be presumed valid because there is substantial compliance with statutory requirements. He states that there is not a U.S. Senate seat on the ballot this year, the header includes "District 25" and "State of Wisconsin," and the election date is listed as Nov. 4.

Analysis: The first identified irregularity is that Candidate Kauther listed the incorrect office on all 45 pages. Where title of office is sought, Candidate Kauther listed "Senate" instead of "State Senate," perhaps leading to the conclusion that Candidate Kauther sought a U.S. Senate seat. However, Candidate Kauther is correct that there will not be a U.S. Senate seat on the ballot this year, and the complete header on all of his pages reads "Senate District 25 State of Wisconsin." In addition, Candidate Kauther noted that he had personally circulated the pages and spoken to every signatory to inform them that he sought a seat in the state Senate. These facts constitute substantial compliance pursuant to GAB § 2.05, and Candidate Kauther's papers are sufficient with regards to the title of the office sought.

The second identified irregularity is that Candidate Kauther listed the election date as "Nov. 4," omitting the year 2014. When the election date is listed but incomplete or incorrect, past policy for this Board and the former State Elections Board found substantial compliance with Wis. Stat. § 8.15 where there was sufficient notice to the signers that the candidate was seeking office at the election immediately following circulation of the nomination papers. Consequently, staff has typically allowed for irregularities in the listed election date where it can be determined that electors understood the nomination papers were for the fall election event.

Finally, all signatures on Page 15 were struck because the circulator failed to provide his municipality of residence as required by Wis. Stat. §8.15(4)(a). However, the circulator of this page was the candidate himself. His municipality for voting purposes is provided at the top of the page. In the past, the Board has found substantial compliance where the missing information is supplied by reference to other information found on the same page. Accordingly, staff recommends adding 8 otherwise valid signatures to the initially approved total.

Recommended Motion: Find Candidate Kauther's nomination papers in substantial compliance, include 8 signatures originally struck, add 48 supplemental signatures, verify 415 valid signatures, and grant ballot access for Candidate Kauther.

Craig Krueger, Candidate for the 25th Assembly District – EL 14-07

Candidate Krueger filed his nomination papers on June 2, 2014. The nomination papers circulated and filed with the Board did not contain a column to obtain a printed name from the signer. As such, all nominations papers submitted by the candidate did not contain a printed name and were deemed invalid. On June 5, 2014, Candidate Krueger filed a complaint under Wis. Stat. § 5.06 challenging the initial decision of the Board staff that determined all of his signatures were invalid. The complaint claims the candidate retrieved the nomination paper form for partisan office (GAB-168) from the Board's website in April and assumed the forms

were up to date and sufficient. Candidate indicates he had no reason to double check the format of his nomination papers before circulating them and that he was not aware of the statutory change (2013 Wisconsin Act 160) which required a legibly printed name to be included in a space next to the signature for the signature to be valid.

Candidate Krueger argues that:

- his nomination papers should be presumed valid based on past decisions of the Board
- just because there is not column for a printed name it does not mean that the signatures obtained are not from qualified electors
- the signature and address demonstrate validity regardless of whether one prints their name or not
- it would seem to be a greater betrayal of citizen trust to keep a candidate's name from the ballot because the forms were not up to date on the GAB website at the time of retrieval than to accept signatures as valid which has the been the precedent thus far.

Candidate Krueger requests that:

• At the very least, he should have the right to submit an affidavit in order to repair the signatures submitted by adding printed names because the deficit is in the signatory section of the form. Submitting an affidavit has been the method of amending other problems in this section of the nomination papers according to guidance issued by the GAB as well as Wis. Admin. Code § 2.05(4).

2013 Wisconsin Act 160 and Relevant Timeline. Assembly Bill 420 which became 2013 Wisconsin Act 160 when signed into law on Thursday, March 27, 2014 became effective on Saturday, March 29, 2014. The Act amended Wis. Stat. § 8.15(2) to state that for a signature to be valid, "each signer of a nomination paper shall legibly print his or her name in a space provided next to his or her signature." The following sets out the timeline of information that was posted to the Board's website regarding the statutory change as well as other events relevant to Mr. Krueger's complaint.

- According to Candidate Krueger's complaint, he retrieved the forms to circulate nomination papers from the G.A.B. website in "early March" to prepare for circulating the papers in April.
- On March 27, 2014 a communication was posted publicly to the Board's website
 outlining the bills recently signed by the Governor which included Assembly Bill 420
 (2013 Wisconsin Act 160). See Memorandum dated March 27, 2014 from Michael
 Haas, Elections Division Administrator and Brian Bell, Elections and Ethics Specialist.
- On April 4, 2014 the revised form GAB-168 Nomination Paper for Partisan Office was posted publicly to the Board's website. The revised form added a column for "Printed Name" and also updated language to the certification statement signed by the circulator.
- On April 11, 2014 a communication was posted publicly to the Board's website
 outlining the requirements of 2013 Act 160 and the proposed standards and review that
 would be used to review nomination papers with the new "legibly printed name"
 requirement. See Memorandum dated April 10, 2014 from Michael Haas, Elections
 Division Administrator and David Buerger, Election Specialist.
- April 15, 2014 was the first day candidates could begin circulating nomination papers for the 2014 Partisan Primary/General Election.

- At the April 17, 2014 Board meeting, the Board discussed in open session the impact of 2013 Act 160 and approved the Board staff's recommendations as to standards of review for legibly printed names. The Board materials for this meeting containing the memorandums on this topic were posted publicly to the Board's website the week of April 7, 2014.
- On April 30, 2014 a communication was publicly posted to the Board's website summarizing legislation relevant to the Board which included a summary of Assembly Bill 240 (2013 Wisconsin Act 160). See Memorandum dated April 30, 2014 from Kevin J. Kennedy, Director and General Counsel and Brian M. Bell, MPA, Elections and Ethics Specialist.
- On May 17, 2014 Candidate Krueger obtained his first nomination paper signature.
- On June 2, 2014, the deadline for nomination papers to be filed, Candidate Krueger filed his nomination papers with the Board and was informed all of his signatures would be invalid.
- On June 5, 2014, Candidate Krueger filed his complaint with the Board.

Board staff responded to Candidate Krueger's complaint on June 5, 2014 (same day it was filed) and instructed him to submit any additional information he would like the Board to consider. Board staff informed Candidate Krueger in writing of the 4:30 p.m. deadline on June 5, 2014 to submit any correcting affidavits to his original filed papers. Candidate Krueger did not file any correcting affidavits.

<u>Analysis</u>: The Wisconsin Administrative Code section that governs the treatment and sufficiency of nomination papers squarely places the burden of preparing nomination papers that comply with statutory requirements on the candidate. "Each candidate for public office has the responsibility to assure that his or her nomination papers are prepared, circulated, signed, and filed in compliance with statutory and other legal requirements." Wis. Admin. Code GAB § 2.05(1). With the burden to assure his nomination papers are compliant with the law squarely on Candidate Krueger, the Board staff addresses his arguments below.

Candidate Krueger's Arguments.

His nomination papers should be presumed valid based on past decisions of the Board. Candidate Krueger correctly states the presumption of validity as it relates to nomination papers contained in Wis. Admin. Code GAB § 2.05(4), but no such presumption can be applied here. Wis. Admin. Code GAB § 2.05(4) states in relevant part, "Any information which appears on a nomination paper is entitled to a presumption of validity." The operative language here is "information which appears" in that Candidate Krueger's papers do not contain the information for which the presumption would apply. The presumption would properly be applied to any legibly printed name that Candidate Krueger supplied "in a space next to the signature" as required by Wis. Stat. § 8.15(2). However, since the nomination papers did not contain a space to capture the legibly printed named of his signers, this did not occur and thus the presumption of validity is not applicable when the information does not exist on the nomination paper. The submission of nomination papers not containing a space to obtain a legibly printed name is an issue of first impression as the Board has not ruled on this issue previously.

Just because there is not a column for a printed name it does not mean that the signatures obtained are not from qualified electors. Board staff does not dispute that the signatures obtained may be of qualified electors of the 25th State Assembly District. However Board staff turns to the relevant language of Wis. Stat. § 8.15(2) which as previously discussed, was recently amended by the State Legislature. "In addition to his or her signature, in order for the signature to be valid, each signer of a nomination paper shall legibly print his or her name in a space provided next to his or her signature..." Wis. Stat. § 8.15(2) (emphasis added). The legislative intent seems to be quite clear in that if a legibly printed name is not provided in a space next to the signature, the signature is not valid regardless of whether it was obtained from a qualified elector. The submission of nomination papers not containing a space to obtain a legibly printed name is an issue of first impression as the Board has not ruled on this issue previously.

The signature and address demonstrate validity regardless of whether one prints their name or not.

Candidate Krueger's argument here attempts to invoke Wis. Admin. Code GAB § 2.05(5) which states, "Where any required item of information on a nomination paper is incomplete, the filing officer shall accept the information as complete if there has been substantial compliance with the law." Again, Board staff believes Candidate Krueger's argument cannot withstand the clear language of Wis. Stat. § 8.15(2) which instructs that "in order for the signature to be valid, each signer of a nomination paper shall legibly print his or her name in a space provided next to his or her signature..." While Wis. Admin. Code GAB § 2.05(5) contains language that helps cure situations in which information may be incomplete but substantial compliance with the law has occurred, in this case, the required information (legibly printed name) as well as the column (printed name) to obtain the required information are completely missing from Candidate Krueger's nomination papers. The submission of nomination papers not containing a space to obtain a legibly printed name is an issue of first impression as the Board has not ruled on this issue previously.

It would seem to be a greater betrayal of citizen trust to keep a candidate's name from the ballot because the forms were not up to date on the GAB website at the time of retrieval than to accept signatures as valid which has the been the precedent thus far. Board staff is sympathetic to Candidate Krueger's situation, staff respectfully disagrees with this argument. The Board is charged with enforcing laws and administrative rules that govern elections in Wisconsin, which include Wis. Stat. ch. 8 and Wis. Admin. Code ch. 2. The Board is tasked with applying and enforcing the rules uniformly to all candidates as written by the State Legislature - this includes 2013 Wisconsin Act 160. Three hundred sixteen candidates for state partisan offices filed their nomination papers with the Board by the June 2, 2014 deadline. Board staff recalls only a small number (less than 5) of candidates that experienced the same or substantially similar issue that Candidate Krueger has presented to the Board for consideration. In most cases, candidates recirculated their nomination papers and submitted signatures that also contained a legibly printed name.

It is true that in early March of 2014 when Candidate Krueger obtained the form GAB-168 from the Board's website it did not contain a column to obtain a legibly printed name – that is because 2013 Wisconsin Act 160 was not signed until March 27 and was not effective until March 29. Once the legislation became law, the Board took all appropriate steps to notify the

public of these changes and to update the GAB-168 on the Board's website for future candidate use. Again, while the Board staff sympathizes with Candidate Krueger's situation, but it is the responsibility of the candidate "to assure that his or her nomination papers are prepared, circulated, signed, and filed in compliance with statutory and other legal requirements." Wis. Admin. Code § GAB 2.05(1).

While Board staff believes distinguishable, it does remind the Board of its 2010 decision in the case of: *Nomination Papers of David Gallo, Spring 2010 Election for Kenosha Unified School District No. 1 School Board and Gilbert Ostman, Clerk, Kenosha Unified School District No. 1*, GAB Case No. EL 10-01 (2010). In this case, Candidate Gallo filed his nomination papers after the statutory deadline contained in Wis. Stat. § 8.10. Based on his late filing, the School District denied Mr. Gallo ballot access. Mr. Gallo provided evidence of and the School District admitted to making mistakes in the information provided to Mr. Gallo regarding the filing deadline. The Board found that Mr. Gallo relied in good faith on the information distributed by the School District and therefore the School District was equitably estopped from enforcing the filing deadline for Mr. Gallo's nomination papers. The Board issued an order certifying Mr. Gallo to the ballot for the 2010 Spring Election.

In the instant matter no such misinformation was present as Mr. Krueger cannot reasonably argue that the GAB-168 he accessed should have contained the newly required information prior to 2013 Wisconsin Act 160 passing the Legislature. Board staff believes that in this case, where no misinformation on a requirement was present, the responsibility to assure nomination papers were in compliance with the law outweighs Candidate Krueger's argument that he relied on the information obtained from the Board's website. Board staff therefore believes that the estoppel remedy espoused in Gallo is not applicable here.

<u>Recommended Motion:</u> The Board dismisses Candidate Krueger's complaint in its entirety and denies ballot status to Candidate Krueger for the reasons referenced above.

Marcia Mercedes Perkins, Candidate for Governor - G.A.B. Case No. EL 14-08

The candidate initially filed approximately 204 pages of nomination papers using a format that did not contain a column to obtain a printed name from the signer. Staff initially invalidated all nomination papers pages. On January 13, 2014, the candidate filed her Declaration of Candidacy (GAB-162) and on June 2, 2014, she filed her nomination papers. The candidate appeals staff's determination that she has not submitted sufficient valid signatures to gain ballot access, in part because registered candidates were not individually informed of the statutory change requiring printed names (2013 Wisconsin Act 160, effective March 29, 2014.) The candidate alleges that the individuals signed her nomination papers in good faith and if she were denied ballot access it would be unjust and discriminatory.

The candidate timely submitted 4 correcting affidavits; however, only two (Sharon Jones and Lawanda Wilard) were notarized as required. In addition, these correcting affidavits only repaired deficiencies with circulator certifications, but did not address the printed name requirement for signers. The two Jones'/Wilard's affidavits may rehabilitate 184 signatures, should the Board waive the Act 160 requirements for printed names.

Staff did review the nomination papers submitted should the Board determine that there was a basis to excuse the Act 160 requirement for printed names; however and even after correcting affidavits, staff were only able to validate 1,855 signatures, which is insufficient for ballot status for the Office of Governor.

Candidate Perkins filed her nomination papers by mail and the G.A.B. received them on June 2, 2014. The nomination papers circulated and filed with the Board did not contain a column to obtain a printed name from the signer. As such, all nominations papers submitted by the candidate did not contain a printed name and were deemed invalid. On June 3, 2014, G.A.B. staff informed Candidate Perkins of the 2013 Wisconsin Act 160 requirement for printed names and that she otherwise did not collect enough signatures to qualify for ballot status. G.A.B. staff informed Candidate Perkins of her ability to file correcting affidavits and provided her with notice that those would have to be filed by 4:30 p.m. June 5, 2014.

On June 4, 2014, Candidate Perkins filed a complaint under Wis. Stat. § 5.06 challenging the initial decision of the Board staff that determined all of her signatures were invalid for failing to meet the 2013 Wisconsin Act 160 requirements for printed names. The complaint claims the candidate never received notice of the new required forms, requests that the 2,040 individuals who signed her nomination papers wish to see her on the ballot and in good faith supported her candidacy, and that denying her ballot status would be unjust and discriminatory. In an additional email dated June 6, 2014, Candidate Perkins stressed that she was not aware of the new requirement, she is a non-politician simply trying to move this state forward, and requests that the Board open the door to their mind to grant her ballot access.

2013 Wisconsin Act 160 and Relevant Timeline. Assembly Bill 420 which became 2013 Wisconsin Act 160 when signed into law on Thursday, March 27, 2014, was published on March 28, 2014, and became effective on Saturday, March 29, 2014. This is roughly two weeks prior to the beginning of the period for circulation of nomination papers on April 15, 2014. The Act amended Wis. Stat. § 8.15(2) to state that for a signature to be valid, "each signer of a nomination paper shall legibly print his or her name in a space provided next to his or her signature." The following sets out the timeline of information that was posted to the Board's website regarding the statutory change as well as other events relevant to Candidate Perkins' complaint.

On March 27, 2014 a communication was posted publicly to the Board's website outlining the bills recently signed by the Governor which included Assembly Bill 420 (2013 Wisconsin Act 160). *See* Memorandum dated March 27, 2014 from Michael Haas, Elections Division Administrator and Brian Bell, Elections and Ethics Specialist.

On April 4, 2014 the revised form GAB-168 - Nomination Paper for Partisan Office was posted publicly to the Board's website. The revised form added a column for "Printed Name" and also updated language to the certification statement signed by the circulator.

On April 11, 2014 a communication was posted publicly to the Board's website outlining the requirements of 2013 Act 160 and the proposed standards and review that would be used to review nomination papers with the new "legibly printed name" requirement. *See* Memorandum dated April 10, 2014 from Michael Haas, Elections Division Administrator and David Buerger, Election Specialist.

April 15, 2014 was the first day candidates could begin circulating nomination papers for the 2014 Partisan Primary/General Election.

On April 15, 2014 Candidate Perkins obtained a substantial number of nomination paper signatures.

At the April 17, 2014 Board meeting, the Board discussed in open session the impact of 2013 Act 160 and approved the Board staff's recommendations as to standards of review for legibly printed names. The Board materials for this meeting containing the memorandums on this topic were posted publicly to the Board's website the week of April 7, 2014.

On April 30, 2014 a communication was publicly posted to the Board's website summarizing legislation relevant to the Board which included a summary of Assembly Bill 240 (2013 Wisconsin Act 160). *See* Memorandum dated April 30, 2014 from Kevin J. Kennedy, Director and General Counsel and Brian M. Bell, MPA, Elections and Ethics Specialist.

On June 2, 2014, the deadline for nomination papers to be filed, Candidate Perkins filed her nomination papers by mail and they were received by the Board.

On June 3, 2014, Board staff informed Candidate Perkins that her nomination papers did not meet the new requirements of 2013 Wisconsin Act 260 regarding printed names and that she otherwise only had 1,671 valid signatures, thus she would not qualify for ballot status. She was also informed of her opportunity to file correcting affidavits.

On June 5, 2014, Candidate Perkins filed her complaint with the Board

On June 5, 2014, Candidate Perkins filed 4 correcting affidavits, only two of which were notarized and which also only corrected certification of circulator errors.

Board staff responded to Candidate Perkins' complaint on June 6, 2014 and instructed her to submit any additional information she would like the Board to consider.

<u>Analysis</u>: The Wisconsin Administrative Code section that governs the treatment and sufficiency of nomination papers squarely places the burden of preparing nomination papers that comply with statutory requirements on the candidate. "Each candidate for public office has the responsibility to assure that his or her nomination papers are prepared, circulated, signed, and filed in compliance with statutory and other legal requirements." Wis. Admin. Code GAB § 2.05(1). With the burden to assure her nomination papers are compliant with the law squarely on Candidate Perkins, she has not submitted enough evidence or argument as to why enforcement of 2013 Wisconsin Act 160 is unfair or discriminatory to her.

While Board staff may be sympathetic to Candidate Perkins' situation and particularly her timeline of events, staff respectfully disagrees with the argument that this was unfair or discriminatory. The Board is charged with enforcing laws and administrative rules that govern elections in Wisconsin, which include Wis. Stat. ch. 8 and Wis. Admin. Code ch. 2. The Board is tasked with applying and enforcing the rules uniformly to all candidates as written by the State Legislature - this includes 2013 Wisconsin Act 160. Three hundred sixteen candidates

for state partisan offices filed their nomination papers with the Board by the June 2, 2014 deadline. Board staff recalls only a small number (less than 5) of candidates that experienced the same or substantially similar issue that Candidate Perkins has presented to the Board for consideration. In most cases, candidates recirculated their nomination papers and submitted signatures that also contained a legibly printed name.

It is true that Candidate Perkins hit the ground running on April 15, 2014 and obtained a substantial number of nomination paper signatures; however, she had two weeks in April and all of May to learn of and correct her errors. Once 2013 Wisconsin Act 160 became law, the Board took all appropriate steps to notify the public of these changes and to update the GAB-168 on the Board's website for future candidate use. Again, while the Board staff sympathizes with Candidate Perkins' situation, it is the responsibility of the candidate "to assure that his or her nomination papers are prepared, circulated, signed, and filed in compliance with statutory and other legal requirements." Wis. Admin. Code § GAB 2.05(1).

<u>Recommended Motion:</u> The Board dismisses Candidate Perkin's compliance review complaint in its entirety and denies ballot status to Candidate Perkins for her failure to comply with the requirement to include legible printed names of each signer of her nomination papers; however, even if this requirement was waived, the Board finds that Candidate Perkins nomination papers only contain 1,855 valid signatures and are insufficient in number for ballot access.

Notifications of Noncandidacy for November 4, 2014 - As of May 23, 2014, 5pm FINAL

Each incumbent officeholder not seeking reelection must file a Notification of Noncandidacy no later than the second Friday preceding the deadline for filing nomination papers. If an incumbent fails to timely file a Notification of Noncandidacy, and does not file nomination papers by the filing deadline, the filing deadline for that office is extended by 72 hours. The extension of the filing deadline does not apply to the incumbent.
