VERIFIED COMPLAINT

I, Joel Gratz, based on information and belief, hereby allege as follows:

1. This Complaint is brought against Scott Espeseth pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 8.15(3) and GAB 2.07, Wisconsin Administrative Code.
2. I am a qualified elector in and resident of the State of Wisconsin. I am Executive Director of the Assembly Democratic Campaign Committee with offices at 15 N. Pinckney Street, Suite 200, Madison, WI 53703.
3. Respondent is Scott Espeseth who maintains an address at 169 North 67th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53213.
4. On or about May 30th, 2014, Respondent filed nomination papers with the Government Accountability Board (GAB) to be placed on the November 4, 2014 ballot for State Representative in the 7th Assembly District. The Respondent's nomination papers contained approximately 400 signatures as determined by initial review of GAB staff.
5. Attached to this verified complaint is Exhibit "A", a full color piece of campaign literature.
6. I received the item in Exhibit "A" when Representative Dan Riemer brought it to me on or around April 21, 2014 when he returned to Madison after the Easter weekend.
7. Attached to this verified complaint is Exhibit "B", a printout of a "Facebook Timeline" for <https://www.facebook.com/scott4wisconsin>, Mr. Espeseth's campaign facebook page.


8. I certify that the Facebook page in Exhibit "B" is accurate as printed when I accessed it on June 5, 2014.
9. Reviewing Mr. Espeseth's nomination papers it appears signature were collected between April 15th, 2014 and May 23rd, 2014.
10. According to the GAB Campaign Finance Information System (CFIS) Mr. Espeseth did not register his campaign committee (Friends of Scott Espeseth) until May 30th, 2014.
11. All nomination signatures collected were prior to Mr. Espeseth's registration with GAB.
12. As the GAB webpage notes "Wisconsin campaign finance law requires candidates for public office to register their intent to run for office, establish a campaign committee to raise and spend money, disclose their campaign receipts and disbursements, and to abide by certain contribution limits and prohibitions." Furthermore the webpages notes: "Every candidate for state office must register with the Government Accountability Board as soon as the individual decides to become a candidate. A candidate must file a campaign registration statement when s/he forms the intent to become a candidate and before circulating nomination papers, receiving contributions, or spending money on the campaign. A candidate must open a campaign depository account at a financial institution and choose a treasurer for the campaign." <http://gab.wi.gov/campaign-finance/registration-state>
13. Exhibit B clearly indicates that Mr. Espeseth had formed the intent to be a candidate when he posted a campaign logo on his Facebook page as early as March 20th, 2014. His Facebook timelines clearly shows ongoing intent to be a candidate in describing public appearances and nomination paper circulation during April and into May of 2014.
14. Mr. Espeseth's distribution of campaign literature obtained in mid-April further demonstrates his intent to be a candidate as suggests activity that required the expenditure of money and registration with GAB.
15. Exhibit "A", campaign literature, contains a disclaimer showing "Authorized and Paid for by Friends of Scott Espeseth, Jennifer Bailey, Treasurer." This disclaimer is fraudulent as no such committee or campaign was registered or existed at the time this literature was distributed and obtained.
16. Complainant respectfully submits that these facts warrant the Board's attention and the Board should take prompt action to eliminate from the nomination papers filed by Respondent who failed to properly register his campaign, circulated nomination papers before registering his campaign, expended campaign funds without proper registration and produced literature with false campaign disclaimers.
17. Complainant further asks the Board to investigate the activities of Mr. Espeseth's campaign to determine if his actions were intentional violations of Wisconsin campaign finance law and subject to criminal prosecution.
18. Complainant reserves the right to amend this complaint with additional information.

I, Joel Gratz, being dually sworn upon oath, state that I personally read the above complaint and that the above listed allegations are true and correct based upon my personal

knowledge and my review of the nomination papers and other public records, and as to those allegations stated on my information and believe, I believe them to be true.
