 - a. One certificate sent immediately by registered mail to the Honorable Joseph R. Biden, President of the United States Senate, United States Senate, Washington, D.C. 20510.
 - b. Two certificates deposited with the Wisconsin Elections Commission; one held subject to the order of the President of the United States Senate, and one preserved for public inspection for one year.

- c. Two certificates sent by registered mail to David S. Ferriero, Archivist of the United States, National Archives and Records Administration, c/o Office of the Federal Register (F), 8601 Adelphi Road, College Park, MD 20740-6001

- 12. Motion in order for adjournment.
- 13. Secretary files with the Wisconsin Elections Commission a certified copy of the minutes of the Presidential Electors meeting, including certification that the six copies of the Certificate of Votes Cast have been disposed of as previously specified and as directed in Section II, Title 3 of the United States Code.
