


BALLOT ACCESS CHECKLIST



FOR 2016 FEDERAL CANDIDATES IN WISCONSIN

Each of the following forms must be completed and filed on time by a candidate for federal office in order for the candidate's name to be placed on the ballot for the August 9, 2016 Partisan Primary and the November 8, 2016 General Election in Wisconsin.



Campaign Finance Registration and Disclosure Requirements. Contact the Federal Election Commission to determine the applicable registration and reporting requirements:

Circulate and obtain sufficient signatures on form **GAB-168, Nomination Paper for Partisan Office**, and submit to the Government Accountability Board (G.A.B.) no later than **5 p.m., on Wednesday, June 1, 2016**. Nomination papers may not be circulated before April 15, 2016. Only original nomination papers will be accepted (no photocopies, faxes or emailed documents). Signatures must be received in the G.A.B. office no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, June 1, 2016 or the candidate's name will not be placed on the ballot. Wis. Stat. § 8.15(1), ch. GAB § 6.04, Wis. Adm. Code.

The number of signatures required are as follows:

United States Senator	2,000 – 4,000
Representative in Congress	1,000 – 2,000



Complete and submit a Declaration of Candidacy (Form GAB-162) to the G.A.B. Form GAB-162 must be received in the G.A.B. office no later than **5 p.m., on Wednesday, June 1, 2016**, or the candidate's name will not be placed on the ballot. If the GAB-162 is faxed or emailed, the original document must follow, postmarked no later than June 1, 2016. Wis. Stat. §§ 8.15(4)(b), 8.21, 8.30(4), ch. GAB § 6.04, Wis. Adm. Code.
