Re: Complaint Filed with Wisconsin Elections Commission Case No.: EL 21-06: Virginia Pease v. Lori Boyer et al.

Dear Ms. Boyer:

This communication is to inform you that a sworn Wisconsin Statute § 5.06 complaint has been filed with the Wisconsin Elections Commission ("Commission") against the Village of Lac La Belle, Village President Tim Clark, and yourself in your capacity as clerk. The complaints relate to events that occurred during the November 3, 2020, General Election cycle. The complaint was filed by Virginia Pease. A copy of the complaint and attachments are included with this letter. The complaint names the aforementioned parties and alleges violations of Wis. Stat. §§ 6.02(1), 8.05(1)(a), and 10.01(2)(a) in relation to the November 3, 2020 election.

As you may be aware, individuals that believe the actions of an election official were contrary to an election law or were an abuse of discretion in applying an election law may file a complaint with our office. To process this complaint, I ask that you provide a sworn written response to the complaint within 10 business days of receipt of this letter and complaint. Your response should address the allegations raised in Ms. Pease's complaint.

After you file your response, Ms. Pease is then afforded the opportunity to file a reply to your response within 10 business days of receipt of your response. Once all the allowable filings have been made, the Commission staff will review the information and draft a decision in consultation with the Commission Administrator. The Administrator will then consult with the Commission Chair and issue the decision, after permitting Commission members an opportunity to provide any feedback.

You may file your response via email addressed to <u>james.witecha@wisconsin.gov</u> so long as it is clear that the original document has been in fact sworn before an individual that can administer oaths, like a notary public. You may also file the response by regular mail to the address listed in the header above.
