SUBJECT: Photo ID Election Day Notice and Acceptable ID Handout

For municipal clerks who will conduct a Spring Primary Election on February 21, 2012, I am pleased to inform you that G.A.B staff has created a new Photo ID Election Day Notice and an Acceptable ID Election Worker Handout for your polling place location(s).

The new Photo ID Election Day Notice should be posted at your polling place (s) along with the other required notices included in the polling place checklist found on Page 35 of the Election Day Manual found on the G.A.B website at: <http://gab.wi.gov/clerk/education-training/election-day-manual>. The Photo ID notice describes the provisions of the Photo ID law and lists the acceptable forms of photo ID electors can use on Election Day to receive a ballot.

The Acceptable ID Election Worker Handout should be distributed to your poll workers. The handout includes samples of the acceptable IDs voters can use on Election Day. It is intended to help your election workers recognize the various types of acceptable ID.

We also encourage you to visit our new Photo ID Public Information Campaign website at <http://bringit.wisconsin.gov/downloads> to download and print additional Photo ID posters, brochures, and printed materials for your polling place location(s). Please note that in the weeks after the Spring Primary Election, the G.A.B. will provide you with all the printed materials found on the Photo ID Public Information Campaign website. However, since our print order has experienced delays, we ask that for the Spring Primary Election you provide your election inspectors with the notice and handout provided in this communication.
