

Dear Overseas Elector,

Recent Wisconsin enacted laws made some changes to the absentee voting processes that affect you and your absentee ballot requests. In the past you, as an overseas elector, have been able to request absentee ballots for all federal elections within two successive general election cycles. You will continue to receive absentee ballots for all federal elections in 2012.

Starting with the 2013 elections, you must make an absentee ballot request each year. To receive absentee ballots for 2013, if there is a federal election, you should complete the enclosed absentee ballot application. Each year you must complete a new absentee ballot application to receive absentee ballots for that year.

Absentee ballot applications may be found online at gab.wi.gov/forms (GAB-121), or you may use the Federal Postcard Application available at fvap.gov. You may also make your request in writing to me via email, fax or by mail. You must include your name, address, the election(s) for which you are requesting an absentee ballot, and the mailing address, email address, or fax number where I should send the ballot.
