

## **Election Day Duties: Special Topics and Situations (poll questions)**

Note: Please remember that most of these do not have 100% correct answers yet and were designed for generating discussion, not actually to be used as a quiz.

1. What do I do if an Election Day Registrant matches someone on the Ineligible Persons List?
  - Notify the voter and deny the voter registration
  - Notify the voter and challenge the ballot if they persist
  - Say nothing and contact law enforcement after they leave
  - Notify the voter and have them vote a provisional ballot
  - Call law enforcement to confirm the criminal conviction
  
2. What do I do if a newly married elector does not have a valid proof of residence with their new name by Election Day?
  - Allow the registration under the old name, if they have POR
  - Allow the registration with the new name, document on GAB104
  - Same as B, but challenge the ballot.
  - Same as B, but have the elector vote a provisional ballot
  - Deny the voter registration and do not issue a ballot
  
3. What do I do if an observer refuses to identify themselves or signs as "concerned citizen"?
  - Let it slide as long as the observer is observing peacefully
  - Order the observer to identify themselves or leave
  - Contact law enforcement
  - Make a up a silly name and make them wear it on a nametag
  
4. What do I do if a campaign is giving rides to the polls and the vehicle is covered in campaign signs/stickers?
  - Allow pick up/drop off outside the 100ft zone only
  - Allow pick up/drop off within 100ft, otherwise stay 100 away
  - Allow the vehicle within 100ft as long as waiting for voters
  
5. What do I do if a member of the media shows up and wants to take pictures/film in my polling place?
  - Ask them to ID themselves and their news organization
  - Permit them to take photos/film if not disruptive
  - Contact your municipal clerk
  - Record the incident on the Inspectors' Statement (GAB-104)
  - All of the above.

6. What do I do if an observer appears to be abusing the challenge process?
  - Refuse to take any further challenges from that observer
  - Ask that observer to leave the polling place
  - Continue to allow the challenges, but contact your clerk
  
7. What do I do if I notice a second adult in a voting booth with an elector who did not previously request assistance?
  - Interrupt the voter and request the second person exit
  - Wait for the voting to conclude and challenge the ballot
  - Ask if the voter requires assistance and get a name/address
  
8. What do I do if an elector presents a "document from a unit of government" that I don't recognize?
  - Refuse to accept it as a valid POR
  - Accept it, but document it on the GAB-104
  - Ask the voter to wait while you confirm the POR is valid
