Question	Answer
Bundling lets you request to print all at the same time, but it doesn't combine all of them?	Correct. Bundling does not combine multiple poll books into one. It allows multiple poll books to be printed with a single request.
When poll books are bundled are they still generated and printed by ward?	For municipalities with a population of over 35000, poll books will continue to be printed by ward. Municipalities with less than 35000 may have multiple wards in a poll book depending on how their reporting units are set up.
Why would we bundle poll books?	Bundling poll books becomes more advantageous for municipalities with many poll books.
Thinking of next spring: if there is no reason for a primary, will we enter the contests under February or April?	Enter them in the April election
For contest numbers assigned, can a number be reused (like using 37000 for two referendums in two separate elections); or does WisVote keep track of contest numbers used and let you know if you are trying to use a number that has already been used?	Ballot position numbers may be reused as long as they are not reused in the same election.
When can we check contests complete and candidates complete?	When you have completed entering contests and candidates that you are responsible for.
Are school district referenda done at each municipal level or how does it distinguish which ballot it should go on in each municipality?	School referendums are entered at the County level and will only appear on the ballot for those municipalities in the school district. Additionally If a municipality has multiple school districts, the referendum will only appear on the ballot for those voters in the referendum school district.
The associated district will be the School District for school district referenda, Correct?	Correct.

Suggestion - it would be nice to have a page where we could see if the state and county have checked off when they've completed entering their contests and candidates.	This will be considered as a change for phase II of WisVote.
To specify a room for a new polling place location, you put it in Polling Place location, correct? Will this room information show up in My Vote?	Yes, MyVote will display the voting room if you specify one in the WisVote polling place information view.
Do cities update County candidates or will the County do that?	The counties are responsible for entering the county-level candidates. Municipalities are unable to enter county candidates in WisVote.
