

FAQs: Election Day Duties: Demonstrations!

Q: Can I be logged on to more than one computer at the same time for the Ineligible List?

A: Yes.

Q: Electronic bank statements only appear to reflect the last 4 digits at this time.

A: Thanks.

Q: Clarification on the write-in votes for optical scan. This also requires completion by two different election inspectors?

A: Yes, using two tally sheets.

Q: If we place the bank account number on the form, doesn't that cause identity theft concerns? Can we use something else from the statement?

A: State statute requires the number for the account, if you can find another number that is unique and identifies the account, go ahead.

Q: I think it is important to note that in order to receive a ballot, someone registering on Election Day must provide proof of residence, so they do not receive a provisional ballot unless they provide POR first, then can't/won't provide the WI driver's license number.

A: A first time voter who registers by mail during open registration and does not include acceptable POR is marked POR REQ on the poll list. If the voter can't provide POR at the polls on election day they can vote a provisional ballot.

Q: Where do I find the Ineligible List?

A: Obtained through CRM. Please contact the Help Desk 608-261-2028.

Q: When we print the poll books we have found when we have downloaded off of the Citrix server, the barcode disappears... Should we be doing something different?

A: Please call the Help Desk and ask for an SVRS Specialist. 608-261-2028.

Q: How/when does a confidential voter come off of the list?

A: Yes, the listing can expire.

Q: Can a county clerk purchase the videos to use in a training session with their municipal clerks and poll workers?

A: They can be viewed on the website for free or ordered with the webinars for a small fee.

Q: Can you review the dates for the late registration period?

A: March 13 - March 28 for the April election.

Q: Can you provide us with a statute number requiring the voter state their full name and address before getting a ballot?

A: 6.79 (2)(a).
