

QUESTIONABLE PROOF OF RESIDENCE

All valid forms of proof of residence must contain the elector's (1) current name and (2) current address.

If the proof of residence has an expiration date, that date must be on or after the date of the election.

Letter or other communication from County Child Support Agency	Mortgage loan statement
Five Day Notice	Great Lakes Higher Education loan statements (private contractor for Federal loans)
Notice of Hearing from unit of government	Health Insurance Statements or bills--This includes statements from entities that contract with state or federal government to administer Medicaid and Medicare.
EMS Bill (if from a unit of government)	ADT, Home Security of America or other home security provider statement.
Letter, notice or tax bill from IRS, DOR, etc.	Notice of foreclosure
Mail from the City Clerk's Office	Other Credit Card Statements (Target, Walmart, CITI, Chase, Am Express, etc)
Notice of Circuit Court date or outcome	State Farm, American Family, Allstate, etc. Insurance Policy
