State of Wisconsin Driver License




Can be expired since last General Election, currently November 4, 2014

State of Wisconsin ID Card



Can be expired since last General Election, currently November 4, 2014

State of Wisconsin Driver License OR State ID Card Receipt




Valid for 45 days from the date receipt was issued

Veterans Affairs ID



Must be unexpired or have no expiration

U.S. Passport Book or Card



Can be expired since last General Election, currently November 4, 2014

Student ID Card



Enrollment Verification



Only valid for voting if the expiration date is no more than 2 years from the date the card was issued

U.S. Uniformed Services



Can be expired since last General Election, currently November 4, 2014

Tribal ID Card



Still valid for voting if expired

Certificate of Naturalization



Only valid for voting if Certificate was issued not more than 2 years before the date of the election
