### Voter Photo ID Law

**WHEN USING A US UNIFORMED SERVICE ID TO VOTE A SEPARATE WI STATE ID IS NOT REQUIRED.**


A US Uniformed Service ID is a photo ID that can be used to vote. Accepted US Uniformed Service IDs should be unexpired, or if expired have expired after the date of the most recent general election; currently, **November 4, 2014**.

### Absentee Ballots

Military persons who vote by absentee ballot by mail are exempt from providing Voter ID.
