Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two-year training terms for municipal clerks begin on January 1 of an even-numbered year and end on December 31 of an odd-numbered year; current term extended one year to 2015-2017.</li> <li>• WEC opinion that election inspectors may not serve at elections where they, their spouse or immediate family member is a candidate on the ballot or where candidate's success or failure may benefit the election inspector financially. Additionally, members of the municipality's governing body may not serve as election inspectors, pages, 10-11.</li> <li>• Chief Inspectors are required to take a self-administered exam as part of training, the results of which to not affect the chief inspector's qualifications to serve, page 13</li> <li>• Election Registration Officials (EROs) replace Election Day Special Registration Deputies, page 13</li> </ul>
Electors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wisconsin Driver License or DOT-issued Identification Card Number language revised to clarify the use of unexpired vs. expired driver license numbers or cancelled state ID card numbers, pages 45, 64-65</li> <li>• POR list updated to include a contract or intake document from an occupant of a residential care facility, page 51</li> <li>• POI list updated to include an unexpired Veterans Affairs ID card, page 56</li> </ul>
Election Day Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clerk's office added as a potential observer location during in-person absentee voting, page 76</li> <li>• Absentee Ballot Canvass location as an observer area no longer in effect for elections after September 17, 2016, pages 76, 78.</li> <li>• Electioneering: solicitations, petitions and exit polls must not interfere with the access of voters entering and leaving the polling place, pages 82 – 83.</li> </ul>
Ballots	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For all elections after September 17, 2016, if the address of the witness is missing, the absentee ballot will be rejected, pages 89, 92</li> <li>• Absentee ballots that do not have the signature of the care representative or proof of identification are rejected, not issued a provisional ballot, page 91.</li> <li>• Processing overvoted and crossover voted ballots in municipalities that do not allow the use of the override function and municipalities that do allow the use of the override function, pages 95-100.</li> <li>• Deadline for candidates to file the a Campaign Registration Statement (ETHCF-1) to be considered a registered write-in candidate is 12 pm the Friday before the election, page 106</li> </ul>
