I Dorothy Kegley, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and states as follows:

On or about March 15, I received a call from a former County Board Member , Shirley Mills, she asked if I knew anything about illegal petitions to recall Jim Holperin, laying on the counter at Schaefer's Store in Crandon. I told her I did not as I had not been there recently. I told her I would go and check it out and if there were petitions unattended I would take pictures.

I went immediately to the store, this was almost closing time, and I did see the unattended petitions on the service counter on the far corner. I asked the young girl if she was in charge of the petitions and she said no, and she didn't know how they got there or anything about them (part of this conversation is on video tape). Another store employee Gloria Walentowski (also on tape) came over and I asked her about them and she too said she did not know but she said she was sure it would not have been the owner, Jay Schaefer, because he would know better. I explained to both girls that it was illegal to leave them out without someone present to watch and verify the people and addresses of the signers were the right ones. They did not remove the petitions and I left. Prior to leaving I noted that their were two pages of signatures, one was full and one had three signers. There was also a form to sign in favor of Jim Holperin.

Mid morning the next day I returned to Schaefer's store. I noted that the petitions were still on the counter. I asked to talk to Jay Schaefer. He said at first the workers at the time behind the counter were responsible for the petitions. I told him about my video of the night before where his clerks denied knowing anything about the petitions. I informed him that it was illegal to leave petitions unattended and that whoever signed they circulated the petitions was breaking the law, as stated at the bottom of each petitions. He said what he was going to do was have the six clerks sign the bottom. I told him he might want to check on that for legality. He was very polite and we went over to remove the petitions. He keep the recall one and let me have the one in favor of not recalling Jim Holperin. He did say that I had to let Holperin know that the signatures came from him. The signature of Dennis Rosa was crossed out from the night before. The next time I saw one page of those petitions was April 25th when I was going through the recall petitions on the Internet. It is

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listed as page no, 2593, dated March 22, 2011(see attachment 1} I have not located the other page yet but I am only on page 3000 at this time.

During our visit Mr. Schaefer did state that also had petitions being circulated in the same matter at his Pickerel Store and gas station. It is unclear if Mr. Schaefer would be vouching as the circulator or one of the clerks for petitions at the Pickerel store.


Diane Fenske Joyner, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and states as follows:

On March 16, 2011 I stopped at Schaefer's IGA in Crandon, WI. While shopping, I noticed at the service counter a sign reading "We Believe in Your Choice". Upon taking a closer look, I realized there were recall Holperin petitions and support Holperin sheets lying on the counter. I asked the clerk behind the desk if she was circulating the petitions. She told me she had no idea where the papers came from and proceeded to tell me she didn't even know what they were for. Given that the petitions were unattended, I took several photos to document this incident. Various names were on the list, some were even crossed off and they appeared to have signed the "support Holperin" petition instead.
