RESOLUTION TO EXCEED REVENUE CAP COMMENCING WITH THE 2015-16 SCHOOL YEAR BY AN AMOUNT OF \$900,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the School District of Florence County, Florence County, Wisconsin, that the final school district budget shall include an amount not to exceed \$900,000 in excess of the revenue limits imposed by Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes each year for a period of three years on a nonrecurring basis, beginning with the 2015-16 school year and ending with the 2017-18 school year, for the purpose of paying District operation and maintenance costs.

QUESTION 1: Shall the School Board of the School District of Florence County be authorized to exceed the revenue limit under Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes beginning with the 2015-16 school year through the 2017-18 school year on a non-recurring basis by an amount of \$900,000 each year for the purpose of paying District operation and maintenance costs as provided in the foregoing resolution?
