JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT
SPRING ELECTION ORIGINALLY HELD APRIL 5, 2011**

APRIL 27, 2011 – MAY 2, 2011

Call to order at 9:00A.M by County Clerk DeeAnn Cook for the purpose of conducting an election recount for the Justice of the Supreme Court race from the April 5, 2011 Spring Election. It was noted that meeting had been properly noticed. Clerk Cook welcomed everyone and went over the observer rules and the oath of office was given to tabulators.

Canvass Board: DeeAnn Cook, Barron County Clerk, Donna Miller, Republican representative, Deb Sirek (substitute for regular board member Bill Smith), Democrat representative who was then substituted by Linda Thompson.

Tabulators: Karn Moe, Town of Prairie Lake Clerk; Sandy Tomczak, Town of Sumner Clerk; Sherrie Siebert, Village of Prairie Farm Clerk/Treasurer; Holly Nyhus, Town of Cumberland Clerk. Later during the first day Jean Foss and Dave Kaseno were given oath and helped roll up Edge tapes for the remainder of day one.

County employee tabulators/helpers: Vonnie Ritchie, Kathy Afdahl, Judy Holloway, Jennifer Horstman (Deputy County Clerk and minute taker) Corp Counsel John Muench was present for the first hour.

Observers: Linda Thompson then Deb Sirek, Kloppenburg representative; Rachel Jacobs, Prosser representative. See sign in sheet for other observers that came and went.

Deb Sirek, substitute Democratic Canvass Board representative hadn't thought about it earlier but asked if it was a problem that she does not live in Barron County. In checking with GAB it was found that the representative must be a resident of the county. At that point, around ½ hour into the recount, Deb Sirek and Linda Thompson traded rolls and Linda Thompson became the Democratic representative on the Board of Canvass. Linda Thompson being Chair of the Democratic Party could make that call to substitute.

The Canvass Board reviewed results from each Barron County municipality for the April 5, 2011 Spring Election for the Justice of the Supreme Court race. Notes detailing findings for each municipality follows.

Below is the order in which municipalities were counted. The reason the municipalities were recounted in such a random order was first due to availability of Insight cartridges plus a municipal clerk being out of town and not getting supplies to County until Monday.

 - Exhibit #2 – Duplicate ballot question
 - Canvass Board concluded voter intent for Prosser – ballot was marked as a duplicate, no change in total as that is the way it was counted on election night.

- Exhibit #3 – Insight rejected entire ballot, Canvass concurs that voter intent is for Kloppenburg
 - Add as (+1) Kloppenburg as a hand count ballot from Insight machine

 - Both tabulators counted 454 voters, but 453 voters were recorded on election day
