Because the number of votes cast was not larger than the number of voters the votes should have counted. The Board added two votes for Kloppenburg.

One paper ballot was rejected because it was not initialed on the reverse side. It was a vote for Kloppenburg so one vote was taken from her total. On May 20<sup>th</sup> the Board of Canvassers reconvened to look at the one ballot that was not initialed. Seal number 0736969 was taken off the bag and the ballot was identified. Because the number of votes cast was not larger than the number of voters the vote should have been counted. The Board added one vote to Kloppenburg.

The absentee voter was not given a number on the poll list but was instead marked with an A. After twice counting the machine ballots there were ten fewer ballots than what the totals showed. The Town Clerk stated that when they changed the paper roll it was put in backwards and a number of voters had voted before it was realized the paper was not being printed. There was no mention of this in the Inspectors Statement. The clerk was asked to bring her Edge Voting Machine in on Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> so the ballots could be recreated. On Monday May 2<sup>nd</sup> the clerk brought the voting machine in. The County Clerk retrieved the Election Day voting machine memory cartridge from the vault. It was installed in the machine and Command Central was called to tell us how to recreate the ballots. When that was completed the paper ballots were counted and the count equaled the totals count. The ballot bag had to be opened after it was sealed because the recreated ballots had not been put inside. It was resealed with seal # 0736989.

The following is taken from the Election Canvass minutes and explains the discrepancies between the votes cast and voters in Wards 3 & 4 and Wards 5 & 6. "City of Mineral Point Wards 3 & 4 showed 220 votes cast and only 209 voters. Wards 5 & 6 showed 108 votes cast with 121 voters. Clerk Klusendorf called Mineral Point City Clerk Debi Heisner to see if she knew what might've caused the discrepancies in the two wards. She stated that she knew exactly what happened. The city has four Aldermanic Districts and parts of three different county supervisory districts. The city wards are as follows: Ward 1 (Aldermanic District 1), Ward 2 (Aldermanic District 2), Wards 3 & 4 (Aldermanic District 3) and Wards 5 & 6 Aldermanic District 4). Debi was in the polling place and heard a voter in Aldermanic District 4 was told it was Wards 3 & 4 instead of Ward 5 & 6. Debi checked with the election inspector and was told that a number of Aldermanic District 4 voters had voted in Wards 3 & 4. When Wards 3 & 4 and 5 & 6 are totaled together there were 328 votes cast and 330 voters. Because it was an election inspector's error the Board decided the votes should stand as they are." The Recount Canvassers also felt the votes should stand as they are. The Board looked at the rejected absentee ballot. It shows her address as 519 Doty Street but one of the election inspectors said she lived at 331 Doty Street so the ballot was rejected. The Certificate was filled out in the Clerk's office and signed by the Clerk. The Board felt that it was the Clerk's error and the ballot should be counted. The vote was for Prosser so the Board added one vote to Prosser. The Board added a number on the poll list for the voter and changed the number of voters to 210.
