Informed by clerk prior to canvass that 1 St. Croix County ballot from the Edge TS machine was put in Pierce County ballot bag. This is why Board began with Village of Spring Valley to identify ballot & send to St. Croix.

Poll books did not match on pg. 71, same 2 numbers used but used in reverse order for husband & wife.

Tabulators identified St. Croix Co. ballot on TS roll. Ballot was separated & confirmed by Board; put in new separate ballot bag; bag signed & sealed by Board with #0579353. Then given to municipal clerk to deliver to St. Croix County Canvass Board.

Tabulators discovered 1 additional Eagle ballot not included in totals; confirmed by Board. Vote was for Prosser & added to his total. Board identified 3 absentee ballots that were rejected by municipal canvass board. GAB-104 indicates reason was because of over voting. Board investigated ballots & discovered that the ballots were over voted in municipal/school offices but not in the office for Justice of Supreme Court. Board determined the votes for JSC should have been counted & included in vote totals. Votes on rejected absentee ballots were 2 for Kloppenburg & 1 for Prosser & added to vote totals by Board. Recount resulted in 2 additional votes for Prosser & 2 additional votes for Kloppenburg. Ballots stapled together & marked as "Exhibit A" then put with other ballots in bag.

Recount adjourned for Village of Spring Valley.

One absentee envelope certificate was found to be unsigned by any witness. Board checked GAB-104 for explanation, none given. After hand counting all ballots it was determined that this absentee ballot was counted & included with original vote totals. Board discussed whether the ballot should have been rejected & how or why this was missed by municipal clerk & election workers. It was determined that the absentee ballot should have been rejected by election workers if they would have realized there was no witness signature. Board performed a draw-down of one absentee ballot per recount procedures detailed in Elections Recount Procedures manual pg. 9 paragraph 4b. All absentee ballots only were sufficiently mixed up face down & placed in empty ballot bag. Board member J. Feuerhelm held bag open while member G. Huber drew out 1 ballot without being able to see in bag. Vote on ballot was for Prosser. All Insight ballots then fed through machine. Machine reported 4 write in votes. Board reviewed write in ballots & discovered 3 ballots did not include a name, 1 other was for Kloppenburg. That vote was added to the Kloppenburg totals. Board member J. Feuerhelm contacted Ross Hein at GAB to apprise of situation & confirmed that the proper procedure was followed. Recount resulted in one less vote for Prosser from original vote totals. Recount adjourned for Town of River Falls.

Board began by announcing that they were informed by the town clerk of River Falls that the absentee ballot that was in question & ultimately rejected by the Board was indeed witnessed by her personally. She was asked to appear at today's meeting & give testimony with regard to the event. Board reopened the recount for the Town of River Falls. Member J. Feuerhelm performed oath for Ruth & Peter Stern to give sworn testimony. Board asked R. Stern to give an account of her recollection of what happened with the one absentee ballot envelope that was not witnessed. R. Stern testified that Sheila Harsdorf came to her home, which is also the clerk's office, to request an absentee ballot on April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011. She said S. Harsdorf was given a ballot & voted & even asked her if she was going to be a witness for her ballot. R. Stern agreed that she would be the witness. R.
