April 27, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 9:03AM.

Julie Glancey confirmed that the meeting was posted on April 25, 2011 at 4:30 PM in compliance with the open meeting law.

Julie Glancey noted that the Request for Recount was filed with the Government Accountability Board on Wednesday, April 20, 2011. The Order for Recount was issued by the Government Accountability Board on April 25, 2011. Both parties were notified of the time and place of the recount.

Julie Glancey and Carl Buesing briefly reviewed the rules for the observers and the procedures that would be followed for the recount.

SPECIAL NOTE: Sheboygan County just completed a county-wide recount for Circuit Court Judge Branch 3. Ballot container seals were verified with the Inspector's Statements during that recount. New seals were placed on the ballot containers by the Board of Canvass upon completion of the recount for that office. The ballot container seals referred to in these minutes are the new seals placed on the ballot containers by the Board of Canvass.

In addition, the discrepancies noted in these minutes were reviewed and reconciled during the Circuit Court recount. All decisions of the Board regarding the Circuit Court recount were revisited and new determinations made. In some cases, such as missing poll list pages, the resolution of the discrepancy for the Circuit Court recount resulted in the discrepancy no longer existing for this recount.

When counting the touch screen ballots the Canvass Board noted that the tape indicated that there were 68 ballots cast on the touch screen but the total ballots tabulated by the Board was only 66. The ballots were recounted and the total was still only 66. The Inspectors Statement noted a problem with the touch screen tape at 7:20 AM. An inspection of the tape revealed an unusual line on the tape. There was no other evidence of the two missing ballots. The totals tape from election night showed votes of 53 for Prosser and 15 for Kloppenburg. The Canvass Board tabulation showed 52 for Prosser and 14 for Kloppenburg. It was the determination of the Board to use the totals from the ballots actually printed on the tape. Canvass member Sertich was opposed to this decision. She would have preferred to use the totals recorded on election night. The candidate representatives had no objections to the Board's decision.

The Inspectors Statement showed 19 Absentee Ballots, but there where two absentee ballots mailed out that where not returned.

At the last recount, the Board found 2 absentee envelopes in the rejected ballots envelope. As the Board could find no reason why those ballots were rejected, they were opened and the ballots counted, increasing the number of absentee voters to 17.

There were 18 ballots identified as absentee ballots. One person was sent an absentee ballot but voted at the polling place. As the total number of ballots and voters matched, the Board speculated that the voter may have brought her absentee ballot to the polling place. No additional action was taken by the Board.

The Inspectors Statement noted that an absentee ballot was remade because it was torn. The torn absentee was found with the spoiled ballots but the duplicate was not identified by the poll workers. There was 1 more regular ballot than regular voter indicating that the ballot had been remade. As the total number of ballots and voters matched no action was taken by the Board. The torn ballot was not counted as its duplicate was included with the regular ballots.

When the Touch Screen Ballot tape was reviewed, there were only signatures on the zero tape, which was taped to the ballot tape and there were no totals at the end of the tape. The zero tape was printed at 6:39 AM on election day and the totals tape was printed at 8:05 PM. The Serial Numbers on all pieces of the tape matched and the serial number is assigned to the tabulator at the Town of Mosel.

The Board further verified that the Protective Counter read 549 at 6:39 AM and 576 at 8:05 PM for a total of 27 votes cast. It was the Board's decision to count the ballots on this tape.
