Dear Mr. Stone:

This communication is to inform you that the verified complaint you filed against various respondents was dismissed by the Wisconsin Elections Commission ("Commission") at its April 20, 2022, meeting.

The Commission passed the following motion in closed session by a 5-1 vote:

Complaint EL 21-37 is dismissed due to lack of reasonable suspicion, and the Commission further finds that the claims against the mayors of Milwaukee, West Allis, and Madison and Michelle Obama are frivolous and orders Mr. Stone to forfeit \$500.

The above-ordered forfeiture of \$500 should be submitted to the P.O. Box listed in the letterhead of this notice, and any check or other form of appropriate non-cash payment should be made payable to the "Wisconsin Elections Commission." This order was directed by the Commission under the authority granted in Wis. Stat. § 5.05(2m)(c)2.am.
