The undersigned, after being first duly sworn, states as follows:

- 1. That your affiant is an adult resident of the State of Wisconsin and is the duly appointed Village Clerk/Treasurer for the Village of Paddock Lake, Kenosha County, Wisconsin; further, that one of the functions of the Village Clerk/Treasurer is to monitor the actions of election inspectors.
- 2. That as to the allegations contained in the Complaint of James Barrette (hereinafter the "Complaint") dated June 30, 2022, following notification by Mr. Barrette that an election inspector, Michael L. Griswold, had remade an absentee ballot which had been rejected by the voting machine, your affiant spoke to Michael L. Griswold and informed him that two inspectors (one from each party) should have been involved in the process. Your affiant was in an adjacent room at the time of notification of this issue. To the best of your affiant's knowledge, there were no further absentee ballots which had been rejected by the voting machine and remade by Mr. Griswold.
- 3. That it was your affiant's impression that Mr. Barrette had advised your affiant immediately upon discovering that an absentee ballot had been remade solely by Mr. Griswold and that was the only absentee ballot which had been remade by Mr. Griswold. Having instructed Mr. Griswold that this practice could not continue, it my impression that the issue was resolved.
- 4. That this Affidavit is made in opposition to the State of Wisconsin Elections Commission Complaint Form filed by James Barrette dated June 30, 2022; further, that your affiant had no notice or knowledge of any other ballots which had been remade solely by Mr. Griswold prior to being notified by Mr. Barrette of the problem.
