RE: Michael L. Griswold Complaint

COUNTY OF KENOSHA

1. I James Barrette worked as an election inspector during date of incident at the first front table checking ID's and having voters sign the book. Michael L. Griswold also worked as an election inspector mostly alone back by the table of absentee ballots and a stack of blank ballots. Mr. Griswold signed in the issue book multiple times having problems with ballots which had to be remade. An open records request would be required to verify how many ballots Mr. Griswold remade.
2. The table Mr. Griswold says was near, was about 20 feet away and behind all other election workers, who were attending to other duties, and unable to closely observe what Mr. Griswold was doing. This is not sufficient oversight in the remake process. He repeatedly ignored requests to stop remaking ballots alone until the clerk came into the room from the front office area. There were voters coming in, so I was going back and forth and unable to watch him. When the clerk came into the room he reluctantly stopped and handed me a ballot, however I had not remade ballots before, so I asked another election inspector what to do with the ballot. I don't recall what happened to the rejected ballot because I never took care of them before and didn't know where rejected ballots went.
3. I did see Mr. Griswold go to a front table on occasion by another election inspector, Linda to initial or sign something. Upon information and belief, Linda and Mr. Griswold are both democrats and there is supposed to be a member of each party present when remaking ballots. This is another violation of election law.

COUNTY OF KENOSHA


1. I James Barrette was working as an election inspector at the time of the complaint in question. I was at the first table checking ID's and having people sign the book as they came in to vote.
2. Michael L. Griswold was working at a table at the back of the room by himself with all the absentee ballots and a stack of blank ballots. He was about 20 feet away and behind the next closest election inspector and unsupervised. Mr. Griswold signed the issue book multiple times indicating he was having issues with ballots which had to be remade. He stopped having ballot issues after I instructed the clerk of what he was doing. An open records request would be required to verify exactly how many ballots Mr. Griswold remade by himself.
3. The Village Clerk, Michelle Shramek set up the table and workers. Mr. Griswold should not have been alone at the table of absentee ballots with a stack of blank ballots unsupervised to decide alone which absentee ballots needed to be remade and subsequently remaking ballots alone. He was 20 feet away and behind the other election inspectors and the clerk was in another room.
4. While I was talking to Mr. Griswold and the clerk Michelle Shramek, another election inspector, Linda came over and said she should be over there with Mr. Griswold. Linda worked as an election inspector working at a front table handing out ballots. However, upon information and belief, Linda and Mr. Griswold are both democrats and there is supposed to be a member of each party present when remaking ballots which is another error by the election clerk.
