Notice of Special Election For Representative to the Assembly Twenty-Fourth District

Election Details

Pursuant to Executive Order #198, issued by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin, dated May 5, 2023, on Tuesday, July 18, 2023, a Special Election will be held in the election district of the Twenty-Fourth Assembly District in the State of Wisconsin, consisting of the parts of Ozaukee, Washington, and Waukesha Counties described in Chapter 4 of the Wisconsin Statutes. The following officer is to be elected:

A Representative to the Assembly for the Twenty-Fourth District

to fill the vacancy, caused by the resignation of Dan Knodl, for the remainder of the term expiring on January 6, 2025.

Primary Election

If necessary, a Special Primary, will be held on Tuesday, June 20, 2023.

For Candidates


