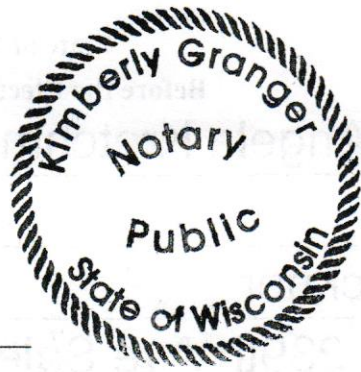

Dear Wisconsin Election Commissioners,

I am writing to formally lodge a complaint regarding serious irregularities that occurred during the August 13, 2024, Election Day at the Village Hall polling location. I believe these issues represent significant violations of Wisconsin election laws and compromise the integrity of the election process.

Specific Complaints

1. **Improper Setup of Voting Machine:**

The only voting machine at the Village Hall was reportedly set up and declared "ready to go" before any election inspectors, including myself, arrived to witness the setup. This is a clear violation of **Wisconsin Statute §7.25(1)**, which mandates that election inspectors must be present during the setup of voting machines. I suspect that Clerk, Renee Brickner, set up the machine early and then left to attend to the second polling location, the church, which raises concerns about accountability and transparency. Furthermore, it was noted that no designated voting machine custodian was present, further exacerbating this violation.

2. **Delayed Opening of Polls:**

Due to the incorrect setup of the voting machine at Village Hall, the polls did not open until 7:13 AM, which is a violation of **Wisconsin Statute §6.78(1m)**. The failure to open the polls on time not only disenfranchised voters but also reflected poorly on the administration of the election, a responsibility shared by both Clerk Brickner and the Village of Bristol.

3. **Lack of Competent Chief Inspector:**

There was no competent chief inspector present at the Village Hall until later in the morning when Clerk Brickner returned from the other polling place. This is a violation of **Wisconsin Statute §7.36 and §7.30(6)(b)**, which requires a designated trained chief inspector to be present and accountable from the start of polling. The confusion among election inspectors and observers about who was in charge — initially indicating different names such as "Dorothy," "Lynn," and "Justin" — demonstrates a clear lack of organization and training. I later learned from both Lynn and Justin that they had not received proper training for their roles. This lack of trained personnel is unacceptable and undermines the electoral process. Clerk Brickner eventually declared herself as chief at approximately 10:00 AM.

Conclusion

The issues described above not only violated state election laws but also created an environment of confusion and disorder at the polling location. The integrity of our elections is of utmost importance, and these incidents cast doubt on the legitimacy of the electoral process in the Bristol community.

The Wisconsin Election Commission must investigate these matters thoroughly and take appropriate action to ensure compliance with state election laws. Additionally, I urge you to consider implementing measures that would prevent similar issues in future elections, ensuring that all election inspectors are adequately trained and that procedures are followed correctly.

Thank you for your attention to this serious matter. If further information such as witness statements, or additional documentation is needed, please let me know and I will be happy to provide them. I have detailed notes and other election inspectors that day can provide their testimony. I look forward to your prompt response.
