**Re:** Complaint Filed with the Wisconsin Elections Commission:  
(EL 24-126) Daniel Kindelberger v. Bobbi Jo Birk-LaBarge

Dear Clerk Birk-LaBarge:

Attached to the email transmitting this notice, please find a sworn Wisconsin Statute § 5.06 complaint filed with the Wisconsin Elections Commission (Commission) by Daniel Kindelberger. The complaint alleges violations of Wis. Stats. §§ 5.84 and 19.90 relating to your office's procedures for which voting equipment was tested during the pre-election test prior to the November 5, 2024, General Election.

Individuals that believe the actions of an election official were contrary to an election law or were an abuse of discretion in applying an election law may file a complaint with the Commission. As Respondent, you may now provide a sworn written response to the complaint within 13 business days of the date appearing on this letter, which is **November 27, 2024**. Your response should address the allegations raised in the complaint.

After you file your response, the Complainant may file a reply within 13 business days of the date that the Commission transmits your response to the Complainant. Once all allowable filings have been received, the Commission staff will review the information and draft a decision letter for the Commission's consideration and decision at an upcoming meeting.

You may file your response via email addressed to [james.witecha@wisconsin.gov](mailto:james.witecha@wisconsin.gov) and [elections@wi.gov](mailto:elections@wi.gov) so long as it is clear that the original document has in fact been sworn before an individual that can administer oaths, like a notary public.
