**Re:** Complaint Filed with Wisconsin Elections Commission

EL 24-91 - Erin Webster v. Suzanne Pinnow

## Dear Clerk Pinnow:

Attached to the email transmitting this, please find a sworn Wisconsin Statute § 5.06 complaint filed with the Wisconsin Elections Commission (Commission) by Erin Webster. The complaint pertains to alleged violations of Wis. Stat. §§ 5.40 and 5.25, as well as 52 U.S.C.A. § 21081(a)(3), concerning the decision not to equip polling places with electronic voting equipment, including accessible voting equipment.

Individuals that believe the actions of an election official were contrary to an election law or were an abuse of discretion in applying an election law may file a complaint with the Commission. As Respondent, you may now provide a sworn written response to the complaint within 13 business days of the date appearing on this letter, which is **September 27, 2024**. Your response should address the allegations raised in the complaint.

After you file your response, the Complainant may file a reply within 13 business days of the date that the Commission transmits your response to the Complainant. Once all allowable filings have been received, the Commission staff will review the information and draft a decision for the Commission's consideration and decision at an upcoming meeting.

You may file your response via email addressed to <u>angela.sharpe@wisconsin.gov</u> and <u>elections@wi.gov</u> so long as it is clear that the original document has in fact been sworn before an individual that can administer oaths, like a notary public.
