RESPONSE OF MARATHON COUNTY CLERK KIM TRUEBLOOD

Marathon County Clerk Kim Trueblood, under oath, provides the following information in response to the Complaint filed by Jo Ann Egelkroun in this matter and dated January 10, 2024.

I. Background Information

I am the Marathon County Clerk, an elected official charged with certain local election duties, including acting as the filing officer for nomination papers filed for county offices. Wis. Stat. § 8.10(6)(b). In my role as Marathon County Clerk, I received nomination papers from Jo Ann Egelkroun for the Spring 2024 election for Marathon County Supervisor of District 3 within Marathon County. These nomination papers were due no later than 5pm on January 2, 2024, and were received timely.

II. Challenge to Signatures

On Thursday, January 4, 2024, Kody Hart, an individual known to me, presented in person to my office at 500 Forest Street in the City of Wausau to indicate his intent to challenge several signatures to Jo Ann Egelkroun's nomination papers. Specifically, Mr. Hart indicated that he wished to challenge a duplicative signature on page 4, line 6, as he believed the signer had previously signed his nomination papers. Additionally, Mr. Hart sought to challenge an illegible signature and invalid address on page 2, line 2 of the submitted papers.

I instructed Mr. Hart, pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.07(2)(a) and Wis. Stat. § 8.07, to provide me with a written complaint outlining supporting evidence for a failure to comply with statutory or legal requirements. Mr. Hart provided a written complaint, dated January 4, 2024, to me by electronic mail. At the time of this instruction, I was unaware of EL 2.07(2)(a) requiring the

form of the complaint to comply with EL 20, nor was I aware of the requirements in EL 20.03(5) that such a complaint included a signed statement under oath. Nonetheless, because Mr. Hart initially presented his complaint to me orally and in person, and followed up in writing, I find that his complaint substantially complied with the filing requirements of EL 20.03, as they were made before me in person as an officer authorized to administer oaths and were followed up in writing. Additionally, the complaint delivered by Mr. Hart was duplicative to determinations I had made in my required review of the nomination papers submitted and would not have changed my determinations relative to disqualification of signatures.

III. Disqualification of Signatures

As the filing officer for Marathon County Board elections, I am charged with reviewing all nomination paperwork filed with my office to determine the facial sufficiency of the papers filed and to ascertain the correctness and sufficiency of information provided on nomination papers. Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(3). Wisconsin administrative rules require me to use Administrative Code section EL 2.05 in determining the validity of all nomination papers and signatures on those papers.

During my review of the nomination papers filed by Jo Ann Egelkrou, I determined that the following signatures were to be disqualified:

1. On Page 1 of the nomination papers, Line 2 includes a signature from Joseph Filak. The address associated with the signature is 601 Garfield Ave. in the City of Wausau. This address lies within Marathon County supervisory district 11. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(a), all signers of nomination papers shall reside in the district which the candidate named on the paper will represent. I determined that Joseph Filak's listed address was outside of the supervisory district at issue, District 3, and that Joseph Filak was not a qualified elector for District 3. Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(15)(e).
2. On page 1 of the nomination papers, Line 3 includes a signature from Patricia Filak. The address associated with the signature is 601 Garfield Ave. in the City of Wausau. This address lies within Marathon County supervisory district 11. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(a), all signers of nomination papers shall reside in the district which the candidate named on the paper will represent. I determined that Patricia Filak's listed address was outside of the supervisory district at issue, District 3, and that Patricia Filak was not a qualified elector for District 3. Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(15)(e).

3. On page 2 of the nomination papers, Line 2 includes a printed name that is illegible along with a signature that is illegible. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), in order for a signature to a nomination paper to be valid, the signer must legibly print his or her name in a space provided next to his or her signature and shall list his or her municipality of residence for voting purposes along with the street and number on which the signer resides. I determined that the signature on line 2 of page 2 did not include a legible printed name and did not include a valid street and number, as 814 ST 1st Ave is not an existing address within the City of Wausau. Additionally, pursuant to Wisconsin Administrative Code Section EL 2.05(15), I determined I was unable to count this signature since the address of the signer was incomplete and residency could not be determined by the information provided on the nomination paper.
4. On page 2 of the nomination papers, line 3 includes the signature of a Cheryl Bahr. This signature is dated January 1, 2024. A Cheryl Bahr with the same address and municipality also signed nomination papers for Kody Hart, another candidate for the same office, on December 22, 2023. Under Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), only one signature per person for the same office is valid. Accordingly, I determined that only Cheryl Bahr's first signature from December 22, 2023, could be accepted as valid under Wisconsin law.
5. On page 2 of the nomination papers, Line 5 includes the signature of a Deanne Taylor. This signature is dated January 1, 2024. A Deanne Taylor with the same address and municipality also signed nomination papers for Kody Hart, another candidate for the same office, on December 22, 2023. Under Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), only one signature per person for the same office is valid. Accordingly, I determined that only Deanne Taylor's first signature from December 22, 2023, could be accepted as valid under Wisconsin law.
6. On page 3 of the nomination papers, Line 8 includes the signature of a Christine Peterson. This signature is dated January 1, 2024. A Christine Peterson with the same address and municipality also signed nomination papers for Kody Hart, another candidate for the same office, on December 22, 2023. Under Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), only one signature per person for the same office is valid. Accordingly, I determined

that only Christine Peterson's first signature from December 22, 2023, could be accepted as valid under Wisconsin law.

7. On Page 4 of the nomination papers, Line 4 includes a signature from Mabel Tousignant. The address associated with the signature is 108 So. 4th Ave. in the City of Wausau. This address lies within Marathon County supervisory district 11. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(a), all signers of nomination papers shall reside in the district which the candidate named on the paper will represent. I determined that Mabel Tousignant's listed address was outside of the supervisory district at issue, District 3, and that Mabel Tousignant was not a qualified elector for District 3. Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(15)(e).
8. On Page 4 of the nomination papers, Line 5 includes a signature from Rayetta Tenney. The address associated with the signature is 402 Elm St. in the City of Wausau. This address lies within Marathon County supervisory district 11. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(a), all signers of nomination papers shall reside in the district which the candidate named on the paper will represent. I determined that Rayetta Tenney's listed address was outside of the supervisory district at issue, District 3, and that Rayetta Tenney was not a qualified elector for District 3. Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(15)(e).
9. On page 4 of the nomination papers, Line 6 includes the signature of a Faustina Mahner. This signature is dated January 1, 2024. A Faustina Mahner with the same address and municipality also signed nomination papers for Kody Hart, another candidate for the same office, on December 22, 2023. Under Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), only one signature per person for the same office is valid. Accordingly, I determined that only Faustina Mahner's first signature from December 22, 2023, could be accepted as valid under Wisconsin law.
10. On Page 6 of the nomination papers, Line 6 includes a signature from Jacob Flath. The address associated with the signature is 1407 Emter St. in the City of Wausau. This address lies within Marathon County supervisory district 10. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(a), all signers of nomination papers shall reside in the district which the candidate named on the paper will represent. I determined that Jacob Flath's listed address was outside of the supervisory district at issue, District 3, and that Jacob Flath was not a qualified elector for District 3. Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(15)(e).

11. On Page 6 of the nomination papers, Line 7 includes a signature from Max Case. The address associated with the signature is 1423 Emter St. in the City of Wausau. This address lies within Marathon County supervisory district 10. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(a), all signers of nomination papers shall reside in the district which the candidate named on the paper will represent. I determined that Max Case's listed address was outside of the supervisory district at issue, District 3, and that Max Case was not a qualified elector for District 3. Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(15)(e).
12. On page 7 of the nomination papers, Line 2 includes the signature of a Gloria Krueger. This signature is dated January 2, 2024. A Gloria Krueger with the same municipality also signed nomination papers for Kody Hart, another candidate for the same office, on December 22, 2023. Under Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), only one signature per person for the same office is valid. Accordingly, I determined that only Gloria Krueger's first signature from December 22, 2023, could be accepted as valid under Wisconsin law. Additionally, Gloria Krueger did not provide a residential address. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), in order for a signature to a nomination paper to be valid, the signer must list the street and number on which the signer resides. I determined that the signature on line 2 of page 7 did not include a valid street and number. Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(12) and (15)(a).
13. On page 7 of the nomination papers, Line 3 includes the signature of a Shawn Zastrow. Shawn Zastrow did not provide a residential address. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), in order for a signature to a nomination paper to be valid, the signer must list the street and number on which the signer resides. I determined that the signature on line 3 of page 7 did not include a valid street and number. Additionally, pursuant to Wisconsin Administrative Code Section EL 2.05(15), I determined I was unable to count this signature since the address of the signer was incomplete and residency could not be determined by the information provided on the nomination paper.
14. On page 7 of the nomination papers, Line 4 includes the signature of a Gene Nelson. Gene Nelson did not provide a residential address. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), in order for a signature to a nomination paper to be valid, the signer must list the street and number on which the signer resides. I determined that the signature on line 4 of page 7 did not include a valid street and number. Additionally, pursuant to Wisconsin

Administrative Code Section EL 2.05(15), I determined I was unable to count this signature since the address of the signer was incomplete and residency could not be determined by the information provided on the nomination paper.

IV. Candidate's Affidavit

On January 5, 2024, after providing Jo Ann Egelkroust with a copy of Kody Hart's challenge, informing her of my initial determinations relative to signatures as outlined in Section III above, and informing her of the ability to correct information by an affidavit as permitted by Administrative Code section EL 2.05(4), Ms. Egelkroust provided a sworn affidavit with addresses for Shawn Zastrow and Gene Nelson and additional information relative to the printed name on page 2 line 2. However, this affidavit did not indicate how Ms. Egelkroust had personal knowledge of the correct information as required by Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(4). I was unable to determine that Ms. Egelkroust had personal knowledge of the corrections and no affidavit of the circulator or the signers were submitted to connect the signatures with the addresses subsequently provided.

V. Decision on Nomination Signatures

After reviewing the affidavit submitted by Ms. Egelkroust, I affirmed my decision that the 14 signatures outlined in section III above were invalid and struck the same from Ms. Egelkroust's nomination papers. In reviewing the remaining signatures, I found that there remained 49 valid signatures. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(3m) and Marathon County General Code § 1.105, the number of signatures required for nomination papers for Marathon County supervisor is not less than 50. Accordingly, I found that Ms. Egelkroust had not submitted sufficient signatures to be added to the ballot for the Spring 2024 election.

VI. Appeal of Jo Ann Egelkroust

I have reviewed the Complaint filed by Jo Ann Egelkroust with the Wisconsin Elections Commission, dated January 10, 2024. Ms. Egelkroust states that five signatures have been incorrectly determined to be invalid and should be counted, giving her 54 signatures and permitting her addition to the Spring 2024 ballot.

A. 14 signatures were struck pursuant to my duties under EL 2.05(3)

Ms. Egelkroust claims that Mr. Hart did not submit a proper verified complaint required by EL 2.07(1). I accepted Mr. Hart's complaint because I found it to be in substantial compliance with the requirements of Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.07(2)(a) and Wis. Stat. § 8.07. Mr. Hart made his complaint to me in person and provided me a follow up complaint in writing outlining the

supporting evidence for his challenges. Mr. Hart followed this process at my instruction, as I was unaware of the requirements in EL 20.03(5) that a complaint include a signed statement under oath. Nonetheless, because Mr. Hart initially presented his complaint to me, an officer permitted to administer oaths, orally and in person, and followed up on this oral complaint in writing, I believe that his complaint substantially complied with the filing requirements of EL 20.03.

Regardless of whether Mr. Hart had provided a valid verified complaint, I have a statutory duty to review nomination paperwork to ensure compliance with election law and regulation. The complaint delivered by Mr. Hart was duplicative to determinations I had made in my required review of the nomination papers submitted and would not have changed my determinations relative to disqualification of signatures. In my role as filing officer for this local election, I exercised my duty to review the nomination papers and to not count invalid signatures as required by Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05. I found that the 14 signatures identified in Section III above could not be counted pursuant to the requirements of Wisconsin law and administrative code, and that Ms. Egelkroust's affidavit did not provide sufficient information, accompanied by personal knowledge, to correct the identified errors.

B. The presumption of validity was rebutted by the errors identified in Section III

Ms. Egelkroust cites EL 2.05(4) and indicates that the nomination papers submitted are entitled to a presumption of validity; however, EL 2.05(5) requires substantial compliance with the law to permit me to accept information as complete. In this case, the nomination papers submitted by Ms. Egelkroust contained the errors listed in Section III above. In applying EL 2.05, the presumption of validity under 2.05(4) was rebutted by these obvious errors. Additionally, the presumption of validity must be read within the context of the other requirements of EL 2.05:

- EL 2.05(11) requires that only one signature per person for the same office is valid
- EL 2.05(12) requires a complete address, including the street and number of the residence for each signature on a nomination paper
- EL 2.05(14) states that no signature may be counted when the residency of the circulator cannot be determined by the information given on the nomination paper
- EL 2.05(15) states that signatures may not be counted when the address of the signer is missing or incomplete or when the individual is not a qualified elector

Ms. Egelkroust submitted nomination papers that included six signatures of individuals outside of District 3, 4 individuals who had previously signed the papers of a different candidate, one

individual whose printed name was illegible and who did not include a valid street and number and provided an incomplete address, one individual who had signed for another candidate previously and who did not provide a complete address, and two individuals who did not include a valid street and number and provided incomplete addresses. EL 2.05 required me to not count these signatures.

C. Ms. Egelkrout's affidavit was insufficient as to personal knowledge of the information contained therein.

Wis. Admin. Code Section 2.05(4) permits a candidate to file an affidavit to correct errors contained within a nomination paper. However, this same code section requires the person giving the correcting affidavit to have personal knowledge of the correct information. Ms. Egelkrout's affidavit contains bare assertions relative to three signatures, those of Shawn Zastrow, Gene Nelson, and one alleged to be from James Chang. However, Ms. Egelkrout does not indicate her basis of personal knowledge for the information provided. Indeed, the signatures identified in her affidavit were obtained not by Ms. Egelkrout herself, but instead by a circulator, Deb Hoppa. Ms. Hoppa provided no affidavit indicating that the signatures attributed to Shawn Zastrow, Gene Nelson, and James Chang were actually obtained from those individuals. There is also no personal knowledge identified that links the provided information with the signatures obtained.

Ms. Egelkrout also does not indicate how she has personal knowledge that the printed name on page 2, line 2 of her nomination papers refers to James Chang. The signature and printed name are both completely illegible. The printed name does not appear to match "James" or "Chang" in any way. There is no way to link the name provided with any elector within District 3.

D. There is insufficient information to confirm that a James Chang signed the nomination papers circulated

In her complaint, Ms. Egelkrout indicates that she determined the name and address on page 2, line 2 of her nomination papers by running his name and address through Google Maps. She provides no information on how she obtained his name and address or linking his name and address to the illegible lines on the nomination papers submitted. She also admits that she did not personally obtain his signature and therefore does not have personal knowledge of the signer of page 2, line 2.

Ms. Egelkrout asks the Commission to use the context of the surrounding signatures to validate the signature of Mr. Chang. However, Wisconsin law requires signers of nomination

papers to legibly print their names specifically to permit local elections officials to verify the validity of the associated signature. Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b). In this case, the printed name is completely illegible. There are no clear marks that correspond to the letters in the name “James Chang.” There is also no law cited that would permit me to disregard the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b) due to the language spoken or written by the signer, if it could be verified that the signer in question did not speak English as a primary language.

I found that, in addition to the illegible name, the address provided was incomplete. The City of Wausau has both a 1st Street and a 1st Avenue. The address in question is listed as 814 ST 1st Ave. I have no records that indicate that a James Chang resides at that address, and Marathon County land records do not indicate that a James Chang is an owner or resident at that address. Additionally, no one with personal knowledge has indicated that Mr. Chang is the person who provided the illegible signature in question.

While the circulator of the nomination paperwork may have circulated page 2 of the nomination papers first on S. 1st Avenue, there is no affidavit based upon personal knowledge that this occurred or that, during this circulation, a James Chang provided the signature on page 2, line 2.

E. The signature on page 7, line 1 was accepted

Ms. Egelkrout’s complaint alleges that the signature on page 7, line 1 of the nomination papers was struck. However, that signature was not struck and was counted as a valid signature in the total of 49 valid signatures identified in my review and after consideration of Ms. Egelkrout’s affidavit.

F. The signatures of Joseph Filak, Patricia Filak, Mabel Tousignant, Rayetta Tenney, Jacob Flath, and Max Case were correctly struck

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(a), and Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(15)(e), all signers of nomination papers shall reside in the district which the candidate named on the paper will represent. The addresses listed for Joseph Filak, Patricia Filak, Mabel Tousignant, and Rayetta Tenney are all addresses located in Marathon County supervisory district 11. The addresses listed for Jacob Flath and Max Case are all addresses located in Marathon County supervisory district 10. Accordingly, each of these six signatures was correctly struck.

G. The signature on page 2, line 2 is illegible and the associated address is incomplete

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), in order for a signature to a nomination paper to be valid, the signer must legibly print his or her name in a space provided next to his or her signature and shall list his or her municipality of residence for voting purposes along with the street and number on which the signer resides. The signature on line 2 of page 2 did not include a legible printed name and did not include a valid street and number, as 814 ST 1st Ave is not an existing address within the City of Wausau. Additionally, pursuant to Wisconsin Administrative Code Section EL 2.05(15), I determined I was unable to count this signature since the address of the signer was incomplete and residency could not be determined by the information provided on the nomination paper.

H. The signatures of Cheryl Bahr, Deanne Taylor, Christine Peterson, Faustina Mahner, and Gloria Krueger were correctly struck

Under Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), only one signature per person for the same office is valid. Each of the above signatures was first provided to nominate another individual for this same office. Those signatures were provided prior to the signatures collected for Ms. Egelkrou. Accordingly, these five signatures were properly struck.

The signature of Gloria Krueger was not accompanied by a valid and complete address. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), in order for a signature to a nomination paper to be valid, the signer must list the street and number on which the signer resides. *See also* Wis. Admin. Code EL 2.05(12) and (15)(a).

I. The signatures of Shawn Zastrow and Gene Nelson were correctly struck

The signatures of Shawn Zastrow and Gene Nelson were not accompanied by a residential address. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.10(4)(b), in order for a signature to a nomination paper to be valid, the signer must list the street and number on which the signer resides. Neither of these signatures included a valid street and number. Pursuant to Wisconsin Administrative Code Section EL 2.05(15), I was unable to count these signatures since the addresses were incomplete and residency could not be determined by the information provided on the nomination papers.

While Ms. Egelkrou attempted to link these names with valid addresses in an affidavit, there was no indication by anyone with personal knowledge (for instance, the circulator), that the person signing each of these lines was the person with the address subsequently offered in Ms. Egelkrou's affidavit. The requirement of personal knowledge for correction of mistakes on nomination paperwork was not met for these signatures.



Hello Clerk Trueblood,

I have reviewed the nomination forms for JoAnn Egelkrout (running for Marathon County Board of Supervisors District 3) and found some discrepancies that may result in not obtaining enough signatures for ballot access. The first is a duplicative signature which brings the total number of valid signatures to 49. The other is a challenge to a signature line for which a determination of validity needs to be made. Please see below for the details on each.

- On the nomination forms of JoAnn Egelkrout, page 4 #6, the signatory had signed my nomination form for the same office on page 5 #1. The name of the signatory is Faustina Mahner. This signatory signed my nomination form on 12/22/2023 and JoAnne Egelkrout's nomination form on 1/1/2024 which according to Wis. Stat. §8.04 makes my signature valid and the signature for JoAnne Egelkrout not valid as mine was attained earlier.
- On the nomination forms of JoAnne Egelkrout, page 2 #2, the signatory did not print his or her name legibly enough to make a determination of validation. Furthermore, there is no valid address on the same line. I am challenging this nomination signature on those grounds and ask that you make a determination on its validity.

The duplicate signature already disqualifies JoAnne Egelkrout for ballot access with only 49 valid signatures when 50 are needed. I will look forward to your final determination on the other discrepancy which I am challenging.

Please confirm receipt and also let me know when you have made a determination on the challenged signature. Thank you for your work!
