I have attached Mr. Mark Aebly's sworn written response to complaint made against him. I would like to mention that I have worked with Mark Aebly during elections for the past 20 years and it has been one of the best experiences of my career.

Mark Aebly takes his duties as Chief Inspector very seriously and makes sure that everything is followed as the Election Manual states.

In all the years with Mr. Aebly, I have never once seen him lose his composure or even get angry.

I would like to mention that on November 5<sup>th</sup> Election Day, I was also at the Town Hall during the entire day. I was going to leave and go to work around 8am, but unfortunately, we had a very large turnout. Our line to get into the Town Hall and vote was down our hallway and out the door and around the parking lot from 7am till at least 11:30am. My workers had a hard time taking any breaks and I tried to help them when needed. I did do some registrations later that day. During the morning, I was helping those on the poll books, handing them the correct ballot that was needed, as the line to vote was getting longer, Mark and myself made the decision to split the poll books. I am not sure at what time in the morning we actually split them, but it had to be around 9am. I was in the Town Hall the entire morning and I did not notice anyone standing around waiting for over an hour as that would have been very noticeable, as we have a very small hall to vote in.

I know you did not ask for my thoughts but felt compelled to say something as Mark and Barbara Aebly are a very important to the Town of Union and the election process.
