SUBJECT: WisVote Training Webinar Series schedule (June 2022 – December 2022)

To supplement our current training program and outreach efforts we have developed a new WisVote training webinar series to cover the 2022 Fall Election cycle and WisVote updates. WisVote webinars are intended for current and possibly future users of the WisVote data management system.

This allows clerks to jump directly to a specific topic covered during a webinar.
