Every two years we are required to facilitate 4-year maintenance. This is the statutory voter list maintenance process where electors who have not voted in the previous four years are contacted and may be deactivated. This webinar will cover how to handle 4-year maintenance cards, the statutory timelines involved, and the importance of recording postcards accurately in WisVote.
