**SUBJECT:** WisVote Training Webinar Series schedule (January 2023 – July 2023)

To supplement our current training program and outreach efforts we have developed a new WisVote training webinar series to cover the 2023 Spring Election cycle and WisVote updates. WisVote webinars are intended for current and possibly future users of the WisVote data management system.

You must be able to view videos on your computer using your computer's speakers and use a media application such as Windows Media Player.

This allows clerks to jump directly to a specific topic covered during a webinar. 
1. Log in to your account and click on the WisVote Webinar Series tile.




2. Click on the webinartitle.
