There was only one man opening the absentee ballots and placing them in the automatic tabulating equipment. There was one woman supervising the automatic tabulating equipment for the in person voters.

This took place 11/8/22 between 12:15-8:00 pm Bristol Village Hall, 19801 83rd St. Bristol, WI 53104

I brought this to the attention of Cheryl Widen about 12:30 pm. She told me I was not to ask any questions.

About 4:00 pm I found out I could make a complaint to Amy Klemko, in the office (where she had been most of the day).

Amy spoke to the woman at the tabulating machine. She (sporadically) helped the man opening the absentee ballots.

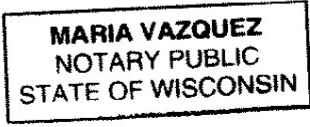
