SUBJECT: ADDENDUM: Ballot Access for Ballot Status and Independent Candidates for President

and Vice President

This is an addendum to pages 174 and 175 of the memorandum titled, "Ballot Access for Ballot Status and Independent Candidates for President and Vice President."

That memo currently states, "Green Party: Jill Stein and Butch Ware: Staff received the completed Declaration of Candidacy from presidential nominee Jill Stein and the certification of the nominees from the chairperson of the Green Party. As of August 21, 2024, staff have not received the completed Declaration of Candidacy from vice presidential nominee Butch Ware. Staff have confirmed with Green Party leadership that the Declaration from Candidate Ware will be provided to the WEC in the coming days. WEC Staff will provide an updated memo to the Commission once the Declaration of Candidacy is received."

On August 26, 2024 the Wisconsin Elections Commission received the Declaration of Candidacy form from Green Party Vice Presidential candidate Rudolph Ware, a copy of which is attached here.

Also, please note that prior to receiving the candidate's DOC, staff utilized Dr. Ware's nickname name from his campaign website on meeting materials, which appeared as "Butch" Ware. Please note that Butch Ware and Rudolph Ware refer to the same candidate throughout these materials. If the Commission approves ballot access for candidate Ware, the name Rudolph Ware will be placed on the ballot as it that is how it appears on the Declaration of Candidacy.

¹ A 1996 constitutional amendment bars any candidate convicted of a misdemeanor which violates the public trust from running for or holding a public office. However, the legislature has not defined which misdemeanors violate the public trust. A candidate convicted of any misdemeanor is not barred from running for or holding a public office until the legislature defines which misdemeanors apply.
