Re: Complaint Filed with Wisconsin Elections Commission: Landwehr v. McMenamin et al. (EL 23-53)

Dear Mr. Landwehr, Clerk McMenamin, Atty. Pomplin, and Atty. Letteney:

This communication is to inform you that the verified complaint that John Landwehr filed against Tara McMenamin, Ian Pomplin, and Scott Letteney was dismissed by the Wisconsin Elections Commission (Commission) at its September 11, 2024, meeting.

The Commission unanimously passed the following language in a motion in closed session:

The Wisconsin Elections Commission finds that the complaint of John Landwehr does not present reasonable suspicion under Wis. Stat. § 5.05(2m)(c)4. that Tara McMenamin, Ian Pomplin, or Scott Letteney violated §§ 12.13(2) or 7.41 by establishing election observation inside of the three-to-eight-foot zone established by the Legislature. The Commission hereby dismisses the complaint.

Additionally, the Commission passed the following language by a vote of 4-2 in a motion in closed session:

The Wisconsin Elections Commission finds that the complaint of John Landwehr was frivolously filed, but does not impose a fine. Staff are directed to publish the closure letter for this matter on the Commission's website.
