MEMORANDUM

DATE: For the Jan. 9, 2024 Commission Meeting

TO: Members, Wisconsin Elections Commission

SUBJECT: Ballot Access for the April 2, 2024 Spring Election

This memorandum presents a summary of noteworthy information about candidates requesting ballot access for the April 2, 2024 Spring Election.

Summary

The nomination paper filing deadline for the 2024 Spring Election for the offices of Court of Appeals judge in Districts I and IV and for circuit court judge in various counties, was 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 2, 2024. The circulation period for nomination papers began on Dec. 1, 2023.

A total of 75 candidates for state offices registered for all offices up at the April election, 71 of whom filed nomination papers with the Wisconsin Elections Commission. There is one candidate for Court of Appeals judge District I, one candidate for District IV, and 69 candidates for 56 circuit court judge positions in 34 counties.

The first nomination papers were filed on Dec. 8, 2023, and six sets of papers were filed on deadline day.

The office of Kenosha County Circuit Court Branch 3 and Winnebago County Circuit Court Branch 1 are the state-level offices that will require a primary on Feb. 20, 2024. Sauk County Circuit Court Branch 3 has an outstanding challenge against one of the three candidates who have filed all necessary documents for ballot access. If the pending challenge is denied, there will also be a primary in the office of Sauk County Circuit Court Branch 3. Local municipalities and school districts may have primaries for local office or have referenda questions on the ballot as well.

Notifications of Noncandidacy

The Notification of Noncandidacy may be filed by an incumbent who is not seeking re-election to the office he or she currently holds. If an incumbent fails to file the Notification of Noncandidacy by the second Friday before the filing deadline - and does not file ballot access documents by the filing deadline - the filing deadline is extended 72 hours for any other candidate for that office. The extension does not apply to the incumbent: Wis. Stat. §8.10(2)(a). The second Friday before the Jan. 2, 2024 filing deadline fell on Dec. 22, 2023.

Staff reached out to incumbent officeholders to ensure that those who did not plan to stand for re-election filed a Notification of Noncandidacy by the deadline so that the ballot certification and preparation process was not delayed. Nine incumbent officeholders timely filed Notifications of Noncandidacy (see Attachment A). All other incumbents submitted nomination papers. Therefore, no extension of the filing deadline was required.

Nomination Paper Review Process

Staff applies nomination paper review standards based on Wis. Stat. §§ 8.10 and 8.30 and Wis. Admin. Code Ch. EL 2 to determine if a candidate has filed a sufficient number of signatures to qualify for ballot access. Attached to this memorandum are the internal nomination paper review standards (Attachment C) and the relevant statutory provisions (Attachment D) used by staff when reviewing papers. Staff also relies on past practices when making recommendations to the Commission as to whether an error on a nomination paper is grounds for striking a signature or page of signatures. This body of precedent comes from Findings of Fact and Orders issued as a result of a challenge to nomination papers, or a compliance review complaint filed under Wis. Stat. § 5.06. Staff accepts all petitions under the presumption of validity as described in Administrative Code EL 2.05(4).

Number of Nomination Paper Signatures Required

- Candidates for court of appeals judge must file a minimum of **1,000** valid signatures of qualified electors from the district to qualify for ballot access. Wis. Stat. § 8.10(3)(am).
- Candidates for circuit court judge in counties over 500,000 in population (Milwaukee County) must file a minimum of 1,000 valid signatures of qualified electors from the district to qualify for ballot access. Wis. Stat. § 8.10(3)(c).
- Candidates for circuit court judge in counties with a population of 500,000 or less must file a minimum of 200 valid signatures of qualified electors from the district to qualify for ballot access. Wis. Stat. § 8.10(3)(b).

Every nomination paper was reviewed separately by two staff members, and a determination regarding sufficiency was made within one business day of submission. This satisfied the staff goal of performing the two reviews within two business days of receiving the nomination papers. 70 of the 71 nomination paper submissions contained a sufficient number of valid signatures. One candidate submitted a correcting affidavit to bring his nomination paper submission up to the minimum 200 signatures ahead of the Friday deadline. As of the deadline for filing nomination papers (Tuesday, Jan. 2, 2024 at 5:00 p.m.), 19 candidates had also filed additional nomination papers to supplement their original filings.

Nomination Paper Copy Requests

To facilitate requests for copies of nomination papers, staff made candidate petitions available for download via the Badger Voters data request site (https://badgervoters.wi.gov/). After the review process was complete, each petition, Declaration of Candidacy, and any supplemental signatures were scanned and uploaded to the site. These documents are available for download at no cost to the requestor. As of Jan. 4, 2024, 29 requests for nomination paper files had been fulfilled through Badger Voters.

Irregularities on Nomination Papers and Ballot Access Documents Not Affecting Ballot Status

One irregularity was detected by staff during the nomination paper and ballot access document review process. Consistent with prior practice and decisions, staff believes this irregularity does not affect ballot access and did not strike signatures or reject filed documents due to this issue. Samples of the issue are in Attachments E.

1. Printed names of signers on nomination papers appear to be written by the circulator.

Staff continues to find printed names of signers and address information that appear to be in the same handwriting as the circulator, although there were fewer instances noticed during this filing period. Wis. Stat. § 8.10 (4)(b) requires the printed name and address information to be made by the signer of the petition, unless the signer requests assistance in signing or printing their name and address. Although staff encounters sporadic examples of this practice on many sets of papers, the most consistent examples over time involve circulators for candidates for Milwaukee County Circuit Court Judge, some of whom are judges themselves. Had staff struck the signatures for this reason, each candidate would still have sufficient signatures. Staff will continue to remind circulators that they can only assist a signer in providing such information if it is specifically requested by the signer.

Statements of Economic Interests

All candidates timely filed the Statement of Economic Interests with the Wisconsin Ethics Commission.

Challenges to Nomination Paper Sufficiency

One challenge to ballot access was received by the deadline of 4:30 p.m. on Friday, Jan. 5, 2024.

Candidates Recommended for Approval of Ballot Status

Staff recommends that the Commission certify ballot access for the 70 candidates listed as "approved" in Attachment B, Candidate Tracking by Office report.

Staff Recommendations for Approval of Ballot Access

A list of candidates recommended for ballot status is included with this memorandum (Attachment B). Staff requests the Commission approve the ballot status of those candidates listed who have met or exceeded the

minimum valid signatures and have filed all necessary ballot access documents. Candidates that the staff have determined meet the required ballot access requirements are marked as "approve" on Attachment B.

This list includes candidates whose nomination papers contain nominal issues such as form template issues, improper but common replacements for office titles, and suspiciously similar handwriting. During its review, Commission staff determined that these minor issues were not detrimental to the sufficiency of the papers, and that the papers substantially complied with all requirements under the applicable laws and administrative code provisions.

Recommended Motion #1: The 70 candidates representing ballot-status parties marked "approve" on the "Candidates Tracking by Office" report are approved for ballot access for the April 2, 2024 Spring Election and Presidential Preference, in addition to any candidates who were subject to challenge but were ultimately approved for ballot access by the Commission.

Staff Recommendations for Denial of Ballot Access

Staff requests the Commission deny the ballot status of those candidates listed who have not met the minimum number of valid signatures, have not filed all necessary ballot access documents or otherwise do not meet the statutory requirements to be placed on the ballot. Candidates that staff have determined do not meet the required ballot access requirements are marked as "deny" on Attachment B.

Recommended Motion #2: The four candidates marked "deny" in Attachment B are denied ballot access for the April 2, 2024 Spring Election and Presidential Preference, in addition to any candidates who were subject to challenge and were ultimately denied ballot access by the Commission.

Challenges to Ballot Status

The deadline for challenges to ballot access was Friday, Jan. 5, 2024. One challenge was filed with the Commission by the deadline of 4:30 p.m. on Jan. 5, 2024.

Challenges will be discussed in a separate memorandum and presented by staff counsel.

Wisconsin Elections Commission: Nomination Paper Review Guidelines

Process Overview

- Use a red pen to mark up the petition during the review process.
- Circle any piece of information on the petition page that is missing or problematic.
- Make a red check to the right of the row to indicate a signature should not be counted.
- Make a red question mark (?) to note questionable signatures that have been counted or to note omitted information on signature line where that signature is still able to be counted.
- Write the number of signatures counted on the upper, right-hand corner of each sheet.

Step 1: Review the Header

Overview: The header of each petition page must contain all the required candidate information. If any of the required information is missing, or incorrect, no signatures on that page can be counted.

Required information:

- 1. Name of candidate
- 2. Residential address of candidate
 - a. Street number and street name (P.O. box addresses are not acceptable)
 - b. Municipality for voting purposes
 - c. State
- 3. Type of election
- 4. Election date
- 5. Title of office sought
- 6. Branch, district or seat number of office sought (if applicable)
- 7. Name of district in which candidate seeks office

Other information:

- Mailing address (only required if different than residential address or voting municipality)
- 2. Zip code (may be present but not required)

Step 2: Review the Certification of Circulator

Overview: The Certification of Circulator section is completed after the signatures on that page have been collected. Each petition page must contain all the required circulator information, the circulator's signature and a certification date that is on or

after the latest date of a signer. If any of the required information is missing or incorrect, no signatures on that page may be counted. If missing circulator information can be determined from another section of the petition page, the signatures on that page should be counted. Most often this occurs when a circulator is also the candidate or has signed that page as an eligible elector.

Residency of Circulator: The circulator does not need to reside in the district represented by the candidate, nor do they need to be a resident of Wisconsin. All circulators must be otherwise eligible to register to vote in Wisconsin (18 years of age, U.S. citizen, not serving any portion of a sentence for a felony offense). They do not need to be registered to vote in Wisconsin or any other state to circulate nomination papers.

Required information:

- 1. Name of circulator Signatures on the page should be counted if the circulator printed their name on the line meant for their signature.
- 2. Address of circulator
 - a. Street number, street name and municipality If missing circulator address, including municipality, can be determined from another section of the petition page, the signatures on that page should be counted.
 - b. State and zip code are not required.
- 3. Date (month/day/year) All signatures must be dated within the circulation period. No signatures should be counted on a page where any portion of the date is missing.
- 4. Signature of circulator Signatures on the page should be counted if the circulator signed on the line that should have the printed name.

Step 3: Review the Body of the Petition

Required information:

- 1. Signature of elector
 - a. Signature does not need be legible.
 - b. Electors may sign with an "X" or other mark if that is their usual signature.
 - c. Signature does not need to be cursive.
- 2. Printed name of elector
 - a. A printed name must be present in addition to the signature of the elector.
 - b. If a possible printed name can be determined, the signature should be counted.

c. If a printed name cannot be determined, the signature should be struck from the petition.

Residential Address

- a. Street name and street number or rural route are required.
- b. Rural address must also include box or fire number.
- c. P.O. boxes are only allowed if they are listed in addition to the residential address information. Signatures where only a P.O. box has been provided should be counted if the municipality of residence is entirely in the district. Mark with a question mark.
- d. Ditto marks are allowed if they follow a valid address and the signer is using those marks to indicate they also reside at that address.
- e. If all or part of the required address information of a signer is missing but residency can be determined by information found in another section of that specific petition page, that signature should be counted. This generally occurs when the signer is also the candidate and/or the circulator and the missing information is in the header or the certification section. Indicate on the petition page where that information is located.

4. Municipality of Residence

- a. Municipality listed must be within the district represented by the candidate.
- b. Abbreviations are allowed (e.g. "FDL" for Fond Du Lac or "Milw" for Milwaukee).
- c. Ditto marks are allowed if they follow a valid municipality and the signer is using those marks to indicate they also reside in the municipality.
- d. The Town/Village/City check box does not need to be checked.
- e. If the municipality of residence was provided in the Residential Address field, the signature should be counted.
- f. If the municipality information of a signer is missing but residency can be determined by information found in another section of that specific petition page (most likely in the header or the Certification of Circulator), that signature should be counted. Indicate on the petition page where that information is located.

5. Date of Signing

- a. A complete date includes the month/date/year.
- b. Date must be within the circulation period.
- c. Date must be on or before the date the page was certified by the circulator.

- d. Ditto marks are allowed if they follow a valid date and the signer is using those marks to indicate they also signed on the same date. If ditto marks are used for the date of the last signer, the signature can be counted if it follows a valid date.
- e. A missing date can be bracketed ([]) if valid and complete dates appear on the line above and the line below the signature line with the missing date.
- f. If the date of the first or last signer is incomplete, it cannot be bracketed, and that signature should not be counted.

Step 4: Count the Signatures

- 1. Sort the petition by the number of valid signatures on each page before determining the final number of valid signatures.
- 2. Place the pages with 10 counted signatures on top, followed by the pages with 9, etc.
- 3. Use a tally sheet or calculator to determine the number of valid signatures on the petition.
- 4. Determine if the number of valid signatures is sufficient for the office sought. Use the appropriate Ballot Access Checklist to determine the signature threshold for the office sought:

a.	County Non-partisan Candidates	ELIS-3
b.	School District Candidates	ELIS-5
c.	Municipal Candidates	ELIS-7
d.	County Partisan Candidates	ELIS-16
e.	Multi-jurisdictional Judge Candidates	ELIS-18

8.10 Nominations for spring election.

(1) Candidates for office to be filled at the spring election shall be nominated by nomination papers, or by nomination papers and selection at the primary if a primary is held, except as provided for towns and villages under s. 8.05. Unless designated in this section or s. 8.05, the general provisions pertaining to nomination at the partisan primary apply.

(2)

- (a) Nomination papers for offices to be filled at the spring election may be circulated no sooner than December 1 preceding the election and may be filed no later than 5 p.m. on the first Tuesday in January preceding the election, or the next day if Tuesday is a holiday, except as authorized in this paragraph. If an incumbent fails to file nomination papers and a declaration of candidacy by the time prescribed in this paragraph, all candidates for the office held by the incumbent, other than the incumbent, may file nomination papers no later than 72 hours after the latest time prescribed in this paragraph. No extension of the time for filing nomination papers applies if the incumbent files written notification with the filing officer or agency with whom nomination papers are filed for the office which the incumbent holds, no later than 5 p.m. on the 2nd Friday preceding the latest time prescribed in this paragraph for filing nomination papers, that the incumbent is not a candidate for reelection to his or her office, and the incumbent does not file nomination papers for that office within the time prescribed in this paragraph.
- (am) If, under par. (a), an incumbent holding local office files written notification that the incumbent is not a candidate for reelection to his or her office or fails to file a declaration of candidacy within the time prescribed in par. (a), the officer or body with whom the declaration of candidacy is required to be filed shall promptly provide public notice of that fact on the officer's or body's Internet site or, if the officer or body does not maintain an Internet site, by posting notices in at least 3 different locations within the jurisdiction that the officer or body serves.
- (b) Each nomination paper shall have substantially the following words printed at the top:
 - I, the undersigned, request that the name of (insert candidate's last name plus first name, nickname or initial, and middle name, former legal surname, nickname or middle initial or initials if desired, but no other abbreviations or titles), residing at (insert candidate's street address) be placed on the ballot at the (spring or special) election to be held on (date of election) as a candidate so that voters will have the opportunity to vote for (him or her) for the office of (name of office). I am eligible to vote in the (name of jurisdiction or district in which candidate seeks office). I have not signed the nomination paper of any other candidate for the same office at this election.
- (c) Each candidate shall include his or her mailing address on the candidate's nomination papers.
- (3) The certification of a qualified circulator under s. 8.15 (4) (a) shall be appended to each nomination paper. The number of required signatures on nomination papers filed under this section is as follows:
- (a) For statewide offices, not less than 2,000 nor more than 4,000 electors.
- (am) For court of appeals judges, not less than 1,000 nor more than 2,000 electors.
- (b) For judicial offices not specified in pars. (a), (am), and (c), not less than 200 nor more than 400 electors.
- (c) For judicial offices in counties over 750,000 population, not less than 1,000 nor more than 2,000 electors.
- (cm) For county executives in counties over 750,000 population, not less than 2,000 nor more than 4,000 electors.
- (cs) For comptrollers in counties with a population of at least 750,000, not less than 500 nor more than 1,000 electors.
- (d) For county executives in counties between 100,000 and 750,000 population, not less than 500 nor more than 1,000 electors.
- (e) For county executives in counties under 100,000 population, not less than 200 nor more than 400 electors.
- (f) For supervisors in counties over 750,000 population, not less than 200 nor more than 400 electors.
- (g) For supervisors in counties between 100,000 and 750,000 population, not less than 100 nor more than 200 electors, except as provided in sub. (3m).

- (h) For supervisors in counties under 100,000 population, not less than 20 nor more than 100 electors.
- (hm) For members of the metropolitan sewerage commission in districts over 1,000,000 population, not less than 1,000 nor more than 2,000 electors, in districts over 200,000 but not over 1,000,000 population, not less than 200 nor more than 400 electors, and in districts not over 200,000 population, not less than 100 nor more than 200 electors.
- (i) For city offices in 1st class cities, not less than 1,500 nor more than 3,000 electors for city-wide offices, not less than 200 nor more than 400 electors for alderpersons elected from aldermanic districts and not less than 400 nor more than 800 electors for members of the board of school directors elected from election districts.
- (j) Except as provided in par. (jm), for city offices in 2nd and 3rd class cities, not less than 200 nor more than 400 electors for city-wide offices and not less than 20 nor more than 40 electors for alderpersons elected from aldermanic districts.
- (jm) For city offices in 2nd and 3rd class cities, not less than 100 nor more than 200 electors for alderpersons who are not elected from aldermanic districts.
- (k) For city offices in 4th class cities, not less than 50 nor more than 100 for city-wide offices and not less than 20 nor more than 40 electors for alderpersons elected from aldermanic districts.

(km)

For a school district officer in any school district described in subd. 1., not less than 20 and not more than 100 signatures if the annual meeting or the school board of the school district adopts a resolution to reduce the number of required signatures and if, on the date that the annual meeting or school board acts under this subdivision, the territory of the school district lying within one or more 2nd class cities is less than or equal to 10 percent of the territory of the school district.
- (ks) For school district officer in any school district which does not contain territory lying within a 1st or 2nd class city, if nomination papers are required under s. 120.06 (6) (a), not less than 20 nor more than 100 electors.
- (L) For other offices, not less than 20 nor more than 100 electors.
- (3m) The county board of any county having a population of at least 100,000 but not more than 750,000 may provide by ordinance that the number of required signatures on nomination papers for the office of county supervisor in the county is not less than 50 nor more than 200 electors. A county that enacts such an ordinance may repeal the ordinance at a later date. Any ordinance changing the number of signatures under this subsection takes effect on November 15 following enactment of the ordinance.

- (a) For a school district that does not contain any territory lying within a 2nd class city on April 18, 2018, the signature requirement for school district officer under sub. - **(6)** Nomination papers shall be filed:
- (a) For state offices or seats on a metropolitan sewerage commission, if the commissioners are elected under s. 200.09 (11) (am), in the office of the elections commission.
- (b) For county offices, in the office of the county clerk or board of election commissioners.
- **(bm)** For municipal judge, if the judge is elected under s. <u>755.01 (4)</u>, in the office of the county clerk or board of election commissioners of the county having the largest portion of the population in the jurisdiction served by the judge.
- (c) For city offices and other offices voted for exclusively within the municipality, except the office of county supervisor, in the office of the municipal clerk or board of election commissioners.
- (d) For school district offices to be voted for within more than one municipality, with the person designated by the school board as the filing official for their school district.

- (c) The candidate, if elected, could not qualify for the office sought within the time allowed by law for qualification because of age, residence, or other impediment.
- (2) If no registration statement has been filed by or on behalf of a candidate for state or local office in accordance with s. 11.0202(1)(a) by the applicable deadline for filing nomination papers by such candidate, or the deadline for filing a declaration of candidacy for an office for which nomination papers are not filed, the name of the candidate may not appear on the ballot. Introduction: The Commission received a sworn challenge against Jesse Leichsenring's nomination papers by Adam Kaney on Friday, January 5. On Friday at 4:13 p.m., Commission staff sent a copy of the complaint to Mr. Leichsenring via electronic mail to <u>jleichsenring@yahoo.com</u>. This is the email address Mr. Leichsenring provided as part of his contact information when he submitted his nomination papers, and staff have since received correspondence from him at this email address. On Monday, January 8, at 3:29 p.m., Commission staff contacted Mr. Leichsenring via email to remind him there was one hour remaining for him to submit a response to this challenge. At 3:46 p.m., Mr. Leichsenring confirmed his intent to speak at the January 9 Commission meeting but did not respond to staff's comment regarding his response. At 3:51 p.m., staff asked Mr. Leichsenring via email if he was going to submit a written response to the challenge. At 3:58 p.m., Mr. Leichsenring responded via email and stated he had not realized staff sent an email with the challenge on Friday, and that he would not be able to submit a written response before 4:30 p.m. No response was received from Mr. Leichsenring before the 4:30 p.m. deadline. Both Mr. Leichsenring and Mr. Kaney have confirmed that they will appear before the Commission during the meeting. The challenge material, and the email exchange described in the paragraph, follows this memo.

This memo will list the relevant information concerning the office, nomination papers, and the challenge, and then discuss the challenges by category.

Discussion: Adam Kaney challenged 4 individual signatures, 3 regarding address issues and 1 regarding elector qualifications. Staff recommend accepting the address challenges but rejecting the qualification challenge under the clear and convincing evidence standard of Wis. Admin. Code § EL 2.07(4).

1. The challenge alleges that the address on line 3 of page 17 (copied below this paragraph) is not within Sauk County but rather is in Dane County. The challenger showed clear and convincing evidence that the address listed, 6885 Taylor Rd, Roxbury lies in Dane County, which is outside of the district. Staff looked up the address using Legislative District Viewer on Legislature's website and found it to lie within Dane County. Because the address is outside of the district, this signature cannot be counted since the singer is not a qualified elector of the district. Wis. Admin. Code s. EL 2.05(6) &(15)(e). See also the signatory requirements in Wis. Stat. s. 8.10(2)(b) & (4).

2. The challenge alleges that the addresses on line 10 of page 17 and line 8 of page 19 (copied below this paragraph) do not exist within the district. The challenger showed clear and convincing evidence that no such addresses as written exist within the district. Staff attempted to find both addresses, 319 Reedburg Road and 302 South Reedsburg, WI on Google Maps, the Legislative District Viewer website, and the Sauk County GIS website, and could not find such addresses, even when accounting for minor spelling errors (Reedburg taken as Reedsburg). Thus, the challenger has met the burden that the signers are not qualified electors of the district because there is no evidence that such addresses exist within the district. Because no such addresses were found within the district, the signatures cannot be counted since the singers are not shown to be qualified electors of the district. Wis. Admin. Code § EL 2.05(6) &(15)(e). See also signatory requirements in Wis. Stat. § 8.10(2)(b) & (4).

3. The challenge alleges that the signer of line 7 on page 9 (copied below this paragraph) is not a qualified elector due to a felony conviction. There is a felon record in WisVote with a matching name, but this alone cannot confirm this allegation because the address in WisVote, which is 809 8th St. Baraboo, WI, is different than what is provided on the nomination paper and in the challenge documents.

However, looking at the CCAP material submitted with the complaint (on page 18), two steps of reasoning could lead to a finding that the challenger met the clear and convincing evidence burden. Sauk County Case 2022CM000597 includes an address of a Jeremy A Giese at 1013 8th St. # 104 Baraboo, WI 53965. The nomination paper says only 1013 8th St. Baraboo, but this is very likely the same address. A separate case, Dodge County Case 2022CF000029, regarding an individual with the same name and birthdate was found guilty of a class H felony on 9/20/2022 and sentenced to 4 years.

While it may be reasonable to assume that the individual with the same name and birthdate connected to the same address is the same person in these two cases, there is a more fundamental issue that the challenger has not addressed. The nomination paper does not contain a birthdate, and staff can see no way to rule out the possibility that this individual may have a relative with the same name living at the same address who is eligible to register to vote and vote. Though it may seem probable that it is the same individual, the relatively common practice of identical family names leads staff to believe that this challenge fails to meet the burden of clear and convincing evidence because of the failure to clearly establish that the individual who signed the nomination paper is the same person who was convicted of the felony offense.

Thus, staff believe that this signature should be presumed valid under Wis. Admin. Code § EL 2.05(4) and that challenge should not be sustained under the elector qualification statute of Wis. Stat. s. 6.03(1)(b). See also Wis. Stat. s. 8.10(2)(b) and Wis. Admin. Code s. 2.05(15)(e).

Recommended Motion 1: The Commission sustains three challenges within Adam Kaney v. Jesse Leichsenring (EL 23-44) and rejects one challenge in accordance with the staff recommendations contained in this memo. The Commission finds that Jesse Leichsenring submitted 197 valid signatures on his nomination papers. The Commission thus denies ballot access to Jesse Leichsenring for submitting less than the minimum number of 200 required signatures on his nomination papers.


- 4. On or about January 2, 2024, Respondent filed nomination papers with the Wisconsin Elections Commission to be placed on the April 2, 2024 ballot for Sauk County Circuit Judge, Branch 3. As of the filing deadline on January 2, The Respondent's nomination papers were shown, on tracking documents posted on the Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC) website (https://elections.wi.gov/elections Nomination Paper Tracking as of 01.02.2024 at 525 pm.pdf) to have 190 signatures as determined by initial review of the WEC staff. That is below the threshold needed (200) for ballot access.
- Subsequently, it appears the Respondent corrected 10 signatures and, as of January 5,
 2024 he is listed on the WEC website with a total of exactly 200 signatures.
- 6. Upon further examination, Respondent's nomination papers contain deficiencies, including signers who live outside the district, signers who indicated an address that does not exist as their residential address, and a signer who is not a qualified elector.
- 7. Respondent's nomination papers contain a total of 4 (four) signatures with insufficiencies, bringing the total number of valid signatures below the 200 signature threshold required to be placed on the ballot for Circuit Court Judge.



Dear Mr. Leichsenring:

This letter is in regard to a complaint filed with the Wisconsin Elections Commission that challenges aspects of your nomination papers. The challenge to your nomination papers will be heard and decided by the WEC at its January 9, 2024, meeting to determine ballot access of candidates for the Spring Primary on February 20, 2024. The meeting will begin at 8:00 a.m. and be held virtually, via Zoom.

If you wish to contest the challenge to your nomination papers, you should file a sworn response to the challenge with the Commission, and you may appear at the Commission's Zoom meeting on January 9. Wis. Admin. Code EL § 2.07(2). A sworn response to the challenge is due by 4:30 p.m., three calendar days after the challenge to your nomination papers is filed. Wis. Admin. Code EL § 2.07(2)(b). The challenge was filed on January 5, 2024, leading to a filing deadline for your response of 4:30 p.m. on Monday, January 8.

Your response may be filed by delivering a copy, or, preferably, emailing it to the Wisconsin Elections Commission. For in-person delivery, please drop the complaint off with a staff member at 201 W. Washington Avenue, 2nd Floor, Madison, Wisconsin 53703. For email delivery, please send the response to both brandon.hunzicker@wisonsin.gov and angela.sharpe@wisconsin.gov. Please include in the email any requests to appear before the Commission and any procedural points of order you plan to raise at the meeting.

A written response to a challenge should identify the nomination paper page and line number of the signature that has been challenged and must rebut the reasons for the challenge.

A written response to a challenge must be verified. A verified response is a response that the respondent (or other affiant) swears, under oath, is true based on the personal knowledge or information and belief of the respondent (or other affiant). The oath must be sworn to before a notary or other person authorized to administer oaths. Banks, UPS Stores, and attorneys can generally help you to have your response sworn by a public notary. Other individuals may also be qualified to administer oaths to swear your response. Remember to bring your photo ID when you have your response sworn. Your response may also be accompanied by affidavits or other documentation supporting your response.

In addition to filing a written response, a challenged candidate may appear, or may send a representative to appear, before the Commission to explain why the challenge ought to be rejected. The parties will be given the opportunity to present arguments in favor of the challenge and in response to the challenge. The challenger and the candidate, or their respective representatives, will each receive five minutes for the presentation.

If you choose to appear before the Commission, please let us know in writing by 4:30 p.m. Monday, January 8, preferably within the email that transmits your response. Please provide:

- 1. Your name and the name of anyone representing you
- 2. Your phone number
- 3. An indication of whether you or someone else will be speaking at the meeting
- 4. An indication of whether you will join via Zoom or call in by phone
 - a. If joining via Zoom, the name of the person who will be presenting must be entered in Zoom exactly as indicated above. Otherwise, we will not know who to unmute when it comes time to present.
 - b. If joining by phone, the phone number of the person presenting must be the same as the number provided above.

If you send the appearance information described above, we will respond by sending instructions for joining the meeting via zoom and phone, as well as what time to appear.

Please also submit any procedural points of order that you plan to raise orally at the Commission meeting in writing along with your response and request to appear before the Commission. The Commission will consider all written challenge and response arguments received by the appropriate filing deadline. In its discretion, the Commission may not consider any non-procedural arguments raised orally that were not raised in the challenge or response by the filing deadline.

The Commission recommends reviewing the published manual titled "Nomination Paper Challenges" prior to responding to a challenge. The manual generally outlines the challenge process, but also includes prior Commission decisions on common challenges, and can be found here:

Candidates should familiarize themselves with Chapter 8 of the Wisconsin Statutes, http://docs.legis.wisconsin.gov/statutes/statutes/8, and Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter EL 2, https://docs.legis.wisconsin.gov/code/admin_code/el/2, which govern nomination papers, nominations, and challenge procedure. Wis. Admin. Code §§ EL 2.05 and 2.07 are the rules governing the treatment and sufficiency of nomination papers and challenges to nomination papers.

Wis. Admin. Code § EL 2.05 sets forth the standards for determining whether nomination papers comply with Chapter 8 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Wis. Admin. Code § EL 2.07 sets forth the bases for challenges to those nomination papers. Wis. Admin. Code § EL 2.05(4) provides that "[a]ny information on a nomination paper is entitled to a presumption of validity," and under Wis. Admin. Code § EL 2.07(3)(a) "[t]he burden is on the challenger to establish any insufficiency" but if the challenge meets this burden, the burden shifts to the challenged candidate to establish sufficiency.
