

RESPONSE TO COMPLAINT

In response to the complaint filed by James Barrette on August 5, 2022, there are a couple of points that I would like to refute.

1. As the Clerk/Treasurer of the Village of Paddock Lake on the February 15, 2022, election I was working in the office at the Village of Paddock Village Hall. There was a Chief Inspector present in the election room during the events in question.
2. I can attest that I did in fact set up the room. After measuring, the room is approximately 15 feet in width, so Mr. Griswold could not be 20 feet away.
3. I do not recall Ms. McKinney saying she should be involved in any of the process, but she declares affiliation with the Democratic party
4. Mr. Griswold in unaffiliated as to my knowledge.
5. Mr. Barrette makes no reference to expressing anything to the Chief Election Inspector on duty during the alleged events.
