**Inactive WisVote users** 

months will receive an email informing them that their WisVote account will deactivated in 15 days if they don't log in. Failure to log in within that 15 days will result in another email informing them that their WisVote account has been deactivated. This action is being implemented to ensure that only those who need WisVote

access have permission to log in. Should someone whose account has been deactivated need WisVote access again, a request for access to the system will need to be resubmitted.


