

## Municipal clerks can start testing their voting equipment for the Partisan Primary on July 30.

July 30 marks when public tests of voting equipment can begin

The test cannot occur more than 10 days before the election. The purpose of the voting equipment test is to ensure that the equipment is programmed correctly and accurately tabulates votes the way they are marked on the ballot.

interact with the voting equipment and learn about how it works. Increased knowledge and comfort with the voting equipment can help poll workers to better explain the voting equipment to voters and troubleshoot potential issues, and it can also help voters confirm that their ballot will be counted exactly how they marked it. Pages 144-147 of the Election Administration Manual review the procedures for public testing of voting equipment.
