

Grant Updates

This subgrant program will disburse up to \$1,200 per municipality for cybersecurity improvements.



- Last day for chairperson of the Wisconsin Elections Commission to certify the results of the Partisan Primary.

November 8, 2022 – General Election February 21, 2023 – Spring Primary (if required)
