





Clerks need to complete EDR postcard reports in WisVote Wisconsin statutes require that after an Election Day Registration by a voter, a postcard must be sent to that voter as a verification measure. As clerks enter their Election Day Registrations from the 2022 General Election, the WEC will send out postcards to these voters informing them of their district information and their polling place. Should you receive any undeliverable EDR postcards, please review the address for any missing information or other obvious errors and compare the voter's address as it appears on the undeliverable postcard to the voter's registration form to look for typographical

If further investigation yields no legitimate reason as to why the EDR postcard is undeliverable, clerks will need to decide, under Wis. Stats. § 6.56(3) and 6.325 (beyond a reasonable doubt standard), whether deactivation of the voter record is warranted and whether a referral needs to be made to their District Attorney's office.


