# Why is addressing so important? Incorrect Pin Location Impacts Wrong Ward/SD/Split information Wrong Reporting Unit assignment Incorrect information on MyVote Wrong ballot style Annexations/redistricting

# Why is addressing so important?


#### **Incorrect Edit or Deactivation Impacts**

Can "move" all voters associated with the address record

Unintentionally deactivate voters records

Lower voter confidence


Creates more work for you






Addressing in WisVote: The Basics **Meet the Pins Green Pin Orange Pin** Pin w/ a hat Lower confidence location Address located w/ high degree of confidence Also used for Geocode Warning **Red Pin** Result of any manual pin move **Black Pin** Turns into Green Pin when saved Low confidence location No record w/ address service Also used for Geocode Exception New construction? Typo?

# Addressing in WisVote: The Basics

#### **USPS** delivery point

No impact on labels or letters

Voters cannot see on any external sites

Loose relation to pin process

11-digits = USPS returned a match for address

0 or 9-digits = No mail delivery/New address/Typo

# Addressing in WisVote: The Basics

#### **Searching Addresses**




Address search tips apply to Address tile & Voter Registration address searches

Less is more – don't need the full address

Full address search often fails

House number + Street name often all that is needed

Always check before creating a new address







# Entering a New Address

#### Placing the map pin



Can move the pin several times – no limit

Get the pin close, then zoom in  $% \left\{ 1,2,\ldots ,2\right\}$ 




Toggle Map & Satellite views to improve accuracy

Once finished, then click Save & Close

#### Placing the map pin

Why not Bing or Google?

# Entering a New Address

#### Placing the map pin

There's no building!

Aerial view can change as you zoom

Road updates more often than aerial photos

Tilt view = faster updates

If still no building, get it on the parcel!



#### **Error Messages**

Don't panic!!

Out of Jurisdiction

Red/Orange pin: Move to correct location

Green pin: Is it in the correct location?

Always check your county GIS to be sure!

# Entering a New Address

#### **Error Messages**

Don't panic!!

**Duplicate Address** 

Checks against Active & Inactive address records


Don't "fix" text to get around error!

Correct/activate inactive record, if one exists

Can't find duplicate or unsure? Contact WEC!



#### **Mass-upload Process**



Create multiple new address records at once

Requires exact coordinates (lat/long)

Excel Spreadsheet available through WisVote News

Email completed spreadsheet back to WEC/Greg

# Updating an Existing Address

#### When to edit/update

Typo in an address element

Local/County readdressing

Address exception

Reactivating an inactive address

#### When not to edit/update

Creating a new address

A voter has moved

Map boundaries are incorrect

# Updating an Existing Address

#### How do you update an address?

Open the address record from the Address tile

Edit the fields needing correction

Click the Process button!

Check/correct map pin


Save & Close

#### What happens after an edit/update?



All associated voter records will reflect the change

All absentee applications associated w/ voters reflect the change
