SUBJECT: Ballot Access for Senate District 13 Special Election

Summary

Due to a resignation of the incumbent State Senator, Governor Tony Evers has issued Executive Order 100 to call a special election to fill the Senate District 13 seat. The special election for this office will be held in conjunction with the April 6, 2021 Spring Election. A primary will be held on the same day as the Spring Primary on February 16, 2021.

The filing deadline for the special elections began on December 22, 2020, and the deadline for filing nominating paperwork was January 8, 2021. Seven candidates have completed a campaign registration statement for the seat, and six candidates have filed all necessary paperwork for ballot access. A primary will be required for all ballot access parties as there are multiple candidates running for the Republican nomination.

Nomination Paper Review Process and Ballot Access Document Filing

Staff continues to use internal nomination paper review standards based on the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. §§ 8.10 and 8.30 and Wis. Admin. Code Ch. EL 2 to determine if a candidate has filed a sufficient number of signatures to qualify for ballot access. During the review process, staff did not identify any irregularities in the nomination papers of the six candidates who filed nomination papers.

The table below lists all of the candidates that filed nomination paperwork, their party, and the amount of signatures identified by staff:
