The Complaint of James Sewell, Complainant against Respondents:

Theresa Itson Sims, Chief Inspector, 1125 College Ave, Racine, WI 5340

and Becky Spika, opened polls, 2713 Loraine Ave, Racine, WI 53404

See attached sheet for all Election Inspectors who worked at the Location (Humble) where Ward 26 voted.

This complaint is under Wisconsin Statutes 5.85(2)(3)(4) and (5).

I, James Sewell, allege that:

In the Fall 2020 General Election Racine Ward 26 Inspectors did not properly mark duplicated ballots. See attached Inspectors' Statement, stating 8 ballots were remade on page 2, and listing 3 incidents. A careful examination of all of the cast ballot images show none had any markings in the area that should be filled out for remade ballots, see attached ballot with the area that should have been filled out circled. There are 133 ballots with the Clerks initials (TC) marked, but the Inspectors' Statement lists 136 absentee voters. There are 41 ballots with Inspectors' initials, but the Inspectors' Statement implies 38 in person voters (174 minus 136). This implies there were 3 absentee ballots remade with ballots initialed by inspectors, but they were not properly marked as Statutes 5.85(2)(3)(4) and (5) require. I can provide the electronic images or printed copies if desired.

It is very important for election integrity to follow Statutes 5.85(2)(3)(4) and (5), so that remade ballots can be compared side by side to their originals to verify that the ballots were remade as to the voter's intent.

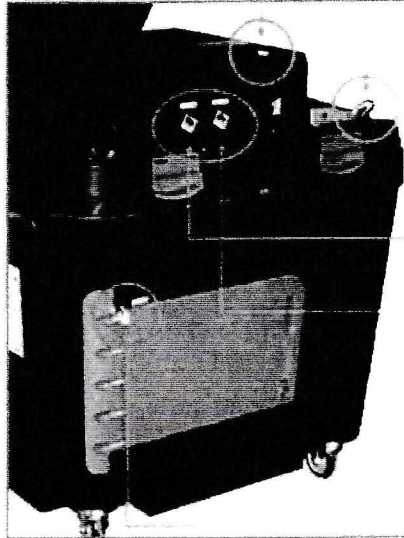

Question 1: Under state law, the increase in the levy of the City of Racine for the tax to be imposed for the next fiscal year, 2021, is limited to 0.15%, based on the City's best estimate, which results in a levy of \$53,000,000.00. Shall the City of Racine be allowed to exceed this limit and increase the levy for the next fiscal year, 2021, for the purpose of paying costs associated with health insurance for the City of Racine retired employees, by a total of 5.49%, based on the City's best estimate, which results in a levy of \$57,400,000.00 in 2021, and an additional \$1,000,000 per year for each fiscal year thereafter?
Question 2: Should the Wisconsin legislature create a nonpartisan procedure for the preparation of legislative and congressional district plans and maps?
