SUBJECT: 2022 Spring Ballot Templates

Sample ballots for the 2022 Spring Primary and Spring Election accompany this memorandum and are submitted to the Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC) for approval.

No changes in format have been made to the Spring Primary and Spring Election ballot samples since the Commission approved the 2021 Spring Ballots. The current design continues to be acceptable to county clerks, voters, ballot printers, and equipment vendors.
