### All That TLC Has to Offer

The end of the 2020-2021 training term is on December 31, 2021, and clerks are required to have at least six hours of training reported to the WEC by this date. If you still need to attend training, you can watch a variety of training videos and webinars all online within The Learning Center (TLC).



TLC allows a clerk to see quick training videos and webinars all in one place. The trainings cover topics like election security, cybersecurity, general WisVote training, and Municipal Clerk Core training. These trainings are interactive, informational, and can be accessed at any time convenient for a clerk. They are not required to be completed in one sitting and can be paused if needed.

Additionally, there are many election administration trainings that have recently been added to TLC that are beneficial for both clerks and election inspectors. The videos walk you through election processes step by step and are a good in-depth view on a variety of topics, including how to review nomination papers, various Election Day tasks at the polling place, and more. These election administration videos are a great resource for both new clerks and clerks that would like a refresher course ahead of the 2022 election cycle.
