



EXECUTIVE ORDER #118

Relating to a Special Election for the Eighty-Second Assembly District

WHEREAS, the Honorable Jeff Stone submitted his resignation as a State Representative for the Eighty-Second Assembly District, effective October 14, 2013.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to article IV, section 14 of the Wisconsin Constitution and section 8.50(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, order that a special election be held on December 17, 2013, to fill the vacancy in the Eighty-Second Assembly District, as created in 2011 Act 43, and whose boundaries are set out in section 4.82 of the Wisconsin Statutes. A copy of the boundary descriptions may be obtained from the Government Accountability Board or the Legislative Reference Bureau. The term for the Eighty-Second Assembly District will expire on the first Monday in January, 2015. If a primary is necessary, it shall be held on November 19, 2013. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin today, October 15, 2013, and nomination papers must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., October 22, 2013, in the office of the Government Accountability Board, 212 East Washington Avenue, Third Floor, Madison, Wisconsin, 53703. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with law.
