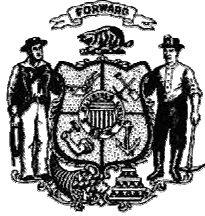

### **NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR A REPRESENTATIVE TO THE ASSEMBLY SIXTY-SIXTH DISTRICT**

January 16, 2018

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** pursuant to a proclamation by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin, dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of November 2017, that on Tuesday, January 16, 2018, a Special Election will be held in the several towns, villages, cities, wards and election districts of the Sixty-Sixth Assembly District in the State of Wisconsin, consisting of those parts of Racine County, as described in Chapter 4 of the Wisconsin Statutes, at which the following officer is to be elected:

**A REPRESENTATIVE TO THE ASSEMBLY FOR THE SIXTY-SIXTH DISTRICT**  
to fill the vacancy, caused by the resignation of the Honorable Cory Mason, for the remainder of the term which expires on January 7, 2019.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that the earliest date for circulating nomination papers is today, Tuesday, November 7, 2017, and the deadline for filing nomination papers for the Special Election will be 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 21, 2017, in the office of the Wisconsin Elections Commission. The Special Primary, if necessary, will be held on Tuesday, December 19, 2017. A description of the boundaries of the 66<sup>th</sup> Assembly District, as created in 2011 Act 43, is set out in 2015-2016 Wisconsin Statutes Section 4.66.
