
It was not until 4:29pm that the information was finally able to successfully transmit, however after doing transmitting in two parts, while the information reads in an email sent box as transmitting finally ahead of the deadline for filing.

The vast number of attached pages to the complaint presented the problem with electronic submission; upon disclosure of the problem with the size of the attachment and the number of pages necessary that Elections Commission Representative Riley, at 4:32pm informed me that since the electronic pages submitted at minimum covered outlining the challenges that I then needed to the following morning hand deliver the pages that were necessary but were unable to be attached.

It is my belief that the Commission should take up these challenges, weight and consider allowing the pertinent and applicable challenges to stand. In addition to the number of pages where circulator information is simply incorrect or missing key parts there are a great number of individual elector signatures that appear to be presented and counted while seemingly unqualified. Those are all in addition to a page that appears to be certified as three unique and separate individuals but all elector fields including print name and signatory fields possess the exact same handwriting; across every field and identifier.

It is due to all of the aforementioned reasons that I feel the Commission should take up, evaluate and consider these challenges filed against the nominating papers for Incumbent Fourth District Senator Lena C. Taylor.
